Changing the Seen & Shaping the Unseen

Seen things have become so real to some people that they have forgotten about the unseen. We live in a world of the natural. We rub shoulders with the physical day after day until the unseen realm seems unreal. We are almost tempted to believe it doesn't exist! But Paul said: ***"For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory; While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal."*** (2 Corinthians 4:17-18)

These words almost cause us to think the Apostle Paul had lost his mind when he said, *"look not at the things which are seen."* How in the world can you look at something you can't see? Paul is talking about unseen principles: the principles of God's Word which are actually spiritual law- spiritual forces that are unseen.

These are eternal forces which always work when you set them in motion.

Notice what the Apostle Paul said: ***"For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory; While we look not at the things which are seen. ..."***

In other words, if you're looking only at seen things, things of the natural, then the affliction will not work an exceeding weight of glory in you. It will work only *while* you're looking at things which are *not seen*. You must shift over into the realm of spiritual law and begin to look at things which are not seen with the natural eye. **You look at things which are not seen with the eye of the spirit - the eye of faith.**

Notice Paul didn't say, *"All affliction will work a far exceeding weight of glory."* He said it would happen only while you're looking at *things which are not seen*.

Ask yourself the question: "What

are the *things which are not seen*?" If you're having financial problems and the bank statement comes back in red ink, then the thing that is *not seen* is the bankbook balancing or your need being met.

The thing that is seen is *lack*. Paul said that pressure will work for you an exceeding eternal weight of glory *if you will look* at things that are *not seen*. It is actually the *looking at the unseen* that brings the glory, not the pressure of the affliction.

This agrees with what he said in Philippians 4:8: ***"Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things."***

You look at things which are not seen with the eye of the spirit – the eye of faith.

In other words, get your mind off the problem and begin to think on the things that are *not seen* – the things you desire, the things you don't see with your physical eye.

You must learn to see the answer by the *eye of faith*.

The word *temporal* means "subject to change." Things you are seeing with the physical, natural eye are always subject to change through spiritual law. So many times what we see with our physical eye does not agree with the Word of God, the promises of God. **The world's system shapes the seen things around**

us. They seem to be very real and they are real; but the Word of God says that they are *subject to change*!

God's Word is the establishing force of the image of unseen things. We should not allow circumstances and the cares of life to create images within us. Take God's Word and change things that are seen - the things you don't desire - into things that you do desire.

I want to show you how to change the seen and shape the unseen.

WRONG ASSUMPTIONS

Words produce images inside us; but sometimes we get these images by making wrong assumptions. Let me give you an example.

During a certain meeting, the Lord had been dealing with me about teaching on this subject of wrong assumptions producing false images. One night after the meeting, the man who took me to the motel was driving a gray-colored Pontiac. The next morning when he came to pick me up, he went out ahead of me to take my bags to the car. He told me he was parked down on the left. I walked out and looked to the left. Seeing a car that looked like his, I started walking toward it. I heard someone blow his horn at me; but when I turned around, I saw a gold-colored Cadillac. Looking for the gray Pontiac I walked on. The man sounded his horn again. Finally, when he backed up and blew the horn again, I looked to see who was in the Cadillac. It was my man. I had an image of him sitting in a gray Pontiac. Because I was looking for a gray Pontiac, I missed him! The car had been right in front of me all the time, but I hadn't paid any attention to it. I just walked right by it.

Because we have not *shaped the unseen* within us, we miss it. We walk by it. We let it go. Sometimes God sets it before us; but because we've never shaped the image of the unseen within us, we keep pushing it out of the way, looking for something else. We're so wrapped up in what is seen that we fail to see the unseen.

CREATING RIGHT IMAGES

We need to recognize one thing: **It is God's Word that will establish the image of the unseen within us.** We should not allow circumstances or the cares of this life to create images within us. *What the Word says* should create the image.

Let me paraphrase what Paul said in 2 Corinthians 4:17-18: "If you don't get rid of that image of looking at the seen and produce another image inside you, then the afflictions of life will not work in you an eternal weight of glory. But they will, if you're looking at the things that are not seen."

We should take God's Word and change the things that are seen – things we don't desire - into the things that we do desire.

The unseen is from the spiritual world.

Someone said, "I can plainly see my financial situation. I can plainly see the red ink on my bank statement." Those are things you can see. The exceeding eternal weight of glory will be brought into place by looking at the unseen. Notice, it is not the affliction that brought glory, but concentrating on the unseen. The unseen is from the spirit world.

Spiritual forces are released by God's Word being spoken. Unseen things are shaped by the Word of God. For example, the Word says: ***"Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again."*** (Luke 6:38)

"He which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully." (2 Corinthians 9:6)

"My God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4: 19)

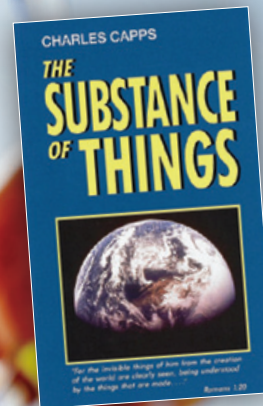
You may not see these things now with your physical eye, but they are very real. They are shaped by *God's Word* and *your confession!* When you look around, you see lack; but God's Word says, *Give, and it shall be given... He which soweth bountifully shall also reap bountifully.* **You change the seen with God's Word. You shape the unseen by calling things that are not as though they were.** (Romans 4:17.)

RENEW YOUR MIND

To get rid of the seen, or what seems to be, you must get your mind and spirit so programmed with the Word of God that you will reject *all* the devil has to offer. Your spirit will scream, *Reject! Reject! It doesn't agree with God's Word!*

Then you begin to shape the unseen by God's Word. God has already had His say on the subject of healing, salvation and prosperity. The problem is that some don't know what He has said, and that enables the devil to take advantage of them.

You change the seen with God's Word.
When you get your mind renewed to the



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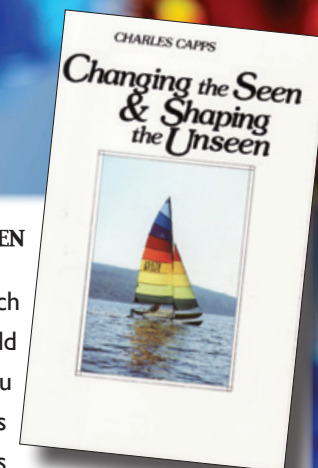


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Word of God and what He has to say about you, then you can operate in faith for your healing and prosperity. But you can't believe any further than you have knowledge. That is why it is important to find out what the Word says about you.

SHAPE THE UNSEEN

Your words are shaping the unseen - daily. That is why God told Joshua: ***"This book of the law (the Word of God) shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success."*** Joshua 1:8

The word *meditate* is interesting. *Meditate* means "to mutter; to speak to one's self." In other words, this is saying, "As you confess what God said about your situation, you will make your way prosperous and do wisely in all the affairs of life." Who was going to make Joshua's way prosperous? Joshua. How? By shaping the unseen with the words of his mouth.

SPEAK THE END RESULTS

Instead of saying what you have, you must speak the end result - what you desire. When you study the New Testament, you'll find that Jesus operated in Kingdom principles. He always spoke the end result, not what was happening.

When Jesus was told that Lazarus was sick (John chapter 11), he said, *"This sickness is not unto death..."* If you interpret that literally, you make Jesus a liar because Lazarus died. But Jesus did not lie. He was speaking the end results. He would never let death in his mouth. He would never establish death upon anyone.

Yes, Lazarus died but Jesus didn't see him dead. Jesus looked beyond the bad news, beyond human emotions. To all outward appearances, He simply ignored what was presently in existence and spoke the end results.

You don't have to accept what you see now. You don't have to go through life with the things that are now seen. Things that are seen are temporal - they are subject to change. Speak God's Word and the end result is victory!

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INTEGRITY

God has been bringing the word “integrity” to my remembrance frequently during the past few months. Because of this, I have studied the word, and I found that Webster’s Dictionary gives three different meanings for “integrity”:

1. The quality or state of being complete; wholeness, entireness, unbroken state.
2. The entire, unimpaired state of or quality of anything; perfect condition, soundness.
3. The quality or state of being of sound moral principle, uprightness, honesty, and sincerity.

The word “integrity” comes from the Latin word *integer*, which means a whole number, not a fraction. The concept behind personal integrity is wholeness. This is the part I want to emphasize: “*The state of being of SOUND MORAL principle.*”

Proverbs 20:7 tells us, “*The righteous man walks in his integrity; blessed - happy, fortunate (enviable) - are his children after him.*” (Amplified)

‘These Things Ought Not So To Be’

I believe we need to ask ourselves the question: “Are we walking in integrity so

our children will be blessed and happy?” There seems to be a decay of integrity in our society today - even in some Christians - and “My brethren, these things ought not so to be” (should not happen), as James says in chapter 3, verse 10.

Proverbs 19:1 tells us, “Better is the poor that walketh in his integrity than he that is perverse in his lips, and is a fool.” And Proverbs 11:3 says, “The integrity of the upright shall guide them: but the perverseness of transgressors shall destroy them.”

These are powerful scriptures and I believe we need to examine our lives to see if we are walking in light of them. Most of us were taught as children not to lie. However, if we are not very careful, most of us could be guilty of this shortcoming, even though we believe ourselves to be an honest person.

For example, employees call in sick to their boss when they need to do something special. People tell the patrolman they weren’t speeding when he stops them. People keep the extra money when they are given incorrect change. (It almost sends cashiers into shock when you hand them back the money and say, “You gave me too much change.”)

Some of the results of all this disregard for truth and integrity are: You

can't pay by check without positive photo identification, and sometimes not at all. Stores have installed hidden cameras to monitor their aisles with sensors in items that set off an alarm, security systems with cameras and motion detectors are used in most homes now. Also, there's the repairman who promises to be there at 9 a.m. and two days later you have to call to see why he didn't come.

It has almost become acceptable, even to Christians, to speak evil against those you don't agree with, inciting hate and division. Jesus said, "...by their fruits ye shall know them." Matthew 7:20

God's Requirement: Speak the Truth

In Ephesians 4:25 we read, "*Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.*" This scripture is also found in Zechariah 8:16, where God's promise to Judah and Jerusalem was

that He would save them and they would be a blessing. But the requirement was to speak the truth (integrity).

There seems to be a decay of integrity in our society today - even in some Christians...

We are going to have to rise up with *integrity* today to be a witness to the world around us! Our words are going to have to be words of truth to our neighbors and brethren.

Jesus said in Matthew 12:36, "*But I tell you, on the day of judgment men will have to give account for every idle (inoperative, non-working) word they speak. For by your words you will be justified and acquitted and by your words you will be condemned and sentenced.*" (vv. 36, 37 *Amplified*).

Let's let our words be words of TRUTH and INTEGRITY!

How to Hear God's Voice

Over the years I've had many people tell me that God doesn't speak to them and they just don't understand why. God is not a respecter of persons. He doesn't favor one person by speaking to them, guiding and directing their life and completely ignore another individual. I am convinced that God tries to speak to each one of us. The problem has been that we did not know *what* to listen for or *how* to listen.

Most people look for God to speak either in an audible voice, a dream or a vision, or deliver a message through an angel. God has spoken through these means and still does today. However these supernatural types of occurrences are the exception rather than the usual. If you expect God to speak to you only in that manner, then you are limiting God and will miss most of God's direction in your life. He uses this extreme means of communicating with you usually when He can't get through to you any other way or if something *very* important is about to take place. We need the direction and guidance of the Holy Spirit in our lives

every day in even minor details.

GOD SPEAKS THROUGH HIS WORD

The first way God speaks to us is through His written Word. As we read and study the Word, the Holy Spirit who is our teacher, quickens truths to our spirits. It is through the Word that our soulish desires and heart desires (which are from God) are divided. The Word of God sheds light on the darkness in the soulish realm and desires not in line with God's will. Hebrews 4: 12-13 says, "*For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart. Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight: but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do.*" If you're not sure if your desires are godly desires, the Word of God will be the guiding line and bring light on hidden motives so that God's desires and your desires will be the same.

THE INWARD WITNESS

Many times people are led by feelings and impressions alone. This is not walking in safety. I believe in being led by the inward witness, but it must also agree with the Word. God does not contradict Himself. The Holy Spirit will never utter one word that contradicts the written Word of God. Be certain where your “impressions” come from. If your spirit is sensitive to the Holy Spirit you’ll also be sensitive to the activities of other spirits and the personalities of people around you. You could think you are “picking something up in the spirit” by the Holy Spirit and the truth is that there are people around you who believe something so strongly that it is pressing upon your spirit. Check it out in the Word. Wait on God. Don’t rush. When God speaks it ministers peace (or harmonizes) in every realm....spiritual, soulish, and physical.

COMMON SENSE

Obviously, when you are dealing with spiritual things, you cannot allow common sense or reason to completely dominate your decision; however, do not throw all common sense out the door. Through your own judgment enlightened by the Spirit of God, you may uncover a hidden trap. The quality of decision you make is determined by the facts and knowledge you have....so get all the facts you can! Making a decision without any knowledge of the situation is like walking a tightrope blindfolded! It’s tricky business at the least.

PROVIDENTIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

We’ve all had providential circumstances in our lives where things happened that were so coincidental that it seemed obvious that it was supernatural, and sometimes they are from God. All open doors, even if the way it

happened is remarkable, require prayer and consideration. You may say, “Well, how then can I be sure God opened the door?” Go back through the steps we’ve mentioned.

1. Does this go against the Word of God in any way?
2. Does my recreated spirit witness to it or do I feel a “check”?
3. Am I sure I have all the facts? Do they make sense?
4. If number 1, 2, and 3 harmonize or bring peace to you, if it just seems “right” in every way, then God has opened the door.

Over the years, I have developed confidence in my ability to hear from God. Yes, I have missed it a few times – usually because I was in a hurry and didn’t take the time to ask God about the situation, or I didn’t get an answer soon enough and felt pressured. I really can’t think of any instances where I prayerfully waited “too long.”

Confidence in the guidance of the Holy Spirit develops as you begin to ask and listen about small matters. As you do, when the big issues arise – like changing jobs, moving, or getting married – you simply follow the same steps that you took in asking God how to handle a problem at home or at work.

Every morning that I begin by asking God’s guidance leads me to His wisdom in every decision and a positive outcome. Wisdom is calling us from His Word. Pay attention!

Proverbs 1:33 (Amplified) *“But whoever listens to me (wisdom) will live securely and in confident trust and will be at ease, without fear or dread of evil.”*

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
