

## Petal and Stem, a Paper-Piecing Class

Saturday, April 20th 10:00 AM til 4:00 PM

**Class Description:** Design the flower garden of your dreams, without getting your hands dirty! Foundation paper-piecing allows you to make small, detailed designs a part of your quilt blocks. In class, you will make one stem/leaf block and one flower block (maybe two if you have time!) and a flower pot. After class, you'll be well on your way to crafting a beautiful garden of intricate flowers! Sherrill will give you tips and tricks to make paper-piecing a new favorite method for quilt blocks.

## **Supply List:**

- Pattern Book: **Petal and Stem**, by Amy Friend \$28.95\* (this book is a great paper-piecing book with many flower and leaf patterns to mix-and-match)
- Sewing Machine w/ new needle, cords and foot pedal, in good working order
- 1/4" foot or an open toe foot that allows you to see the line you're stitching on
- Basic Sewing Supplies (scissors, pins, seam ripper, etc.)
- Rotary Cutter
- 6 ½" ruler for trimming blocks
- 12" or 18" ruler for longer cuts
- Small Cutting Mat
- Foundation Paper (printed papers are available at Quilted Works for \$2)
- Fabric Glue Pen
- Add-a-Quarter ruler
- Add-an-Eighth ruler (recommended)
- Tweezers (recommended)
- Hera Marker or Seam Roller (recommended)

## **Fabric Requirements:**

Quilted Works will have a kit available with leaf, flower and background fabrics (12 fat quarters) and a small fabric piece for flower pot to get you started (\$44.99). A separate kit will be available with the foundation paper needed for the class (\$2).

After class, you will be able to choose how many more blocks you would like to make and the layout of your project. This will determine the amount of fabric you need.

## If you are bringing your own fabric, you will need:

- Scraps of assorted flower colors
- Scraps of assorted leaf/stem colors
- Scrap for a flower pot
- Four to six yards of background fabric, depending on your project size. This could be scrappy or a single fabric. For class, you will need 3-5 fat quarters to give you variety.

\*Not all blocks in our sample quilt are available in this book. Additional petals, stems and critters are available at www.duringquiettime.com from \$3.50 to \$12 for pdf patterns. Some are singles and some are in pairs or groups.

All required supplies are available at Quilted Works. You will receive a discount when purchasing supplies for this class. You will also receive a discount in the shop on the day of your class.
