

## COFFEE TRANSPARENCY REPORT

2022

Director of Coffee, Freda Yuan, on an unpredictable year of rising costs, and maintaining relationships.

The price of coffee has been extremely volatile over the course of the last year. The aftermath of extreme weather in Brazil, including severe frosts, and prolonged droughts, heavily influenced coffee production, leading to low supply and high demand, which, in turn, impacted the commodity coffee price.

In the beginning of 2022, the commodity coffee price hit the second-highest price in recorded history, at \$2.55 per lb. We worked closely, negotiating fairly, with many of our long-term coffee producers, paying \$2.90 per lb. Previously, the price we paid to coffee producers (for coffee with a score of 83+) sat at 90% above the commodity coffee price. This number shrunk, on average, by 33% this last year.

Origin remains wholly committed to de-commoditising the coffee price market, however, some countries, such as Colombia, Peru, and Africa, are still highly affected by the market price, and we had to accept that, unfortunately, some coffee became too expensive for us to purchase. At the same time, we recognise that a shift to a higher commodity coffee price has enabled producers to not only cover their production costs, but make a profit out of it, too.

Thanks to our direct trade strategy, we were able to negotiate with many coffee producers first-hand, avoiding the negative impact from the fluctuating market, and agreeing on fair prices for both parties. Factoring in the rise of overall production costs to due to inflation, fertiliser, fuel, and labour, we mutually agreed to pay 20% more than the previous contracted price. This increase resulted in acting

as a key reason for our overall coffee price increasing drastically compared to 2021.

Another financial challenge for 2022 rose in the shape of changes to the GBP and US dollar currency exchange rate. The war between Russia and Ukraine, alongside other unprecedented events, has led to fluctuations. The value of 1 GBP previously held a conversion rate to 1.35 USD; this dipped to 1.07 USD, before bouncing back up to 1.20 USD. This meant a rise in the cost of green coffee, which we've always contracted in USD. Comparing 1.35 USD to 1.07 USD, the cost of coffee increased by 24.7%. We have remained cautious, and not committed to any contract while unfavourable exchange rates remain; it is likely that this issue will continue to affect costs throughout 2023.

This report represents 100% of purchased coffee in 2022.
