Men's Hairdresser of the Year Jonathan Andrew is here to help you look the part this Valentine's Day...



MEN'S ROOM

■ t's that time of year when romance really kicks off and Valentine's Day means many a date night for the guys so it's important to get your hair looking spot-on for the love in your life.

LOOK THE PART

I see Valentine's hair working best as a slight variation of a red carpet look with a softer finish. You don't want to look too try-hard so make sure you incorporate some texture or volume into your style so it's not too 'done'. Working backwards, you need to strike the right balance. Some guys do too little and the style won't last all night. Read on for my guide to looking fresh this Valentine's Day.

LONGER HAIR

Bradley Cooper has had so many different styles but I think his most famous and copied is that longer textured style (think The Hangover). This look is so versatile in my opinion, great for those growing out their hair, or your desired finish. those that have a curlier texture. Mist is some MR. Sea Salt Spray and blow-dry back with slight volume throughout the front. Don't worry about fully drying the hair, as you can overdo it. Use a little MR. Paste and work from the back to the front of the head, before lightly brushing into shape and holding with some MR. Fix Spray.

SHORTER HAIR

With shorter hair it can seem like there isn't much that can be done, but don't be fooled. There are so many options here in terms of what you can achieve from messy texture to a more groomed of the hair and styling finish. Ryan Gosling is a great example of how short hair looks great as he sits bang in the middle of cool and smart keeping hair a little longer and textured (but slightly tapered on the side) gives the opportunity for you to play around with the look. I'd suggest opting for a parting with this cut as it keeps the hair flatter and looks groomed but carefree at the same time. Use some



Matrix Smooth Setter and blow-dry damp hair backwards and away from your preferred parting then lightly lift from the roots with some Matrix Matte Definer or MR. Gel depending on

Another notable mention here is Ryan Revnolds, his recent shorter looks have garnered attention and I think it's a great option for guys with curlier hair or simply wanting a more textured, less formal look. Achieve this by applying some Matrix Mineral Booster and blow-drying and finishing MR. Wax, working into the roots into shape, leaving you with a light gloss finish.

UNDERCUT

Look to David Beckham as your inspiration here - he was one of the pioneers of this undercut style that so many guys have

coveted. Again, a very versatile shape as you can work with your natural texture to get a really soft finish or blow-dry into shape for a groomed and polished look. Use some Matrix Grip Definer in damp hair and blow-dry the hair back with as much lift as possible. Aim to make your hair almost comically big so that you can flatten and mould into shape - too little and the style can fall apart. Once dry, lightly brush your hair back. If you still need more volume, just lightly backcomb the roots at the front to help. If you need more texture in your hair, use some Matrix Matte Definer and massage into your roots, styling with your fingers for definition. For a groomed look, use some MR. Paste in your hair and slick back with a comb, holding into place with some strong-hold hairspray.
