## **MANUAL**

• Make sure the filtration is on. Adjust the pH between 7.0 and 7.4 The shelves are designed to be placed in a skimmer or in a floating diffuser, provided this is suitable.

In outdoor swimming pools, maintain a stabilizer concentration of between 25 and 50 mg / l. Provide 1 tablet for 2 m3 of water, every 7 to 10 days.

• Not recommended as a permanent water treatment for vinyl coated swimming pools (liners, etc.)

Before swimming, fill a clean bucket with 10 liters of water, remove the diffuser from the pool and place it in the bucket of water. Keep the set in a safe place, outdoors, away from bathers. After swimming, replace the diffuser in the basin and then pour the contents of the bucket into it as well. • Placed in direct contact, this product can discolor a vinyl coating (liner, etc.). • Before using this product, you must read all instructions and safety instructions. • Contamination or improper use of this product may cause fire, explosion or release of toxic gases • This product must never be in contact or mixed with any other treatment product anywhere (bucket, dispenser, floating diffuser, skimmer, container, etc.) • Keep in a dry place, in a well-ventilated place, at an average daily temperature not exceeding 35 ° C • DO NOT MIX WITH ANY OTHER PRODUCT.
