The chilled coffee market has transformed radically from its early sugar-filled days. Here are five of the best new wave serves for cool caffeination on the go.



COFFEE SUPREME LONG BLACK

Crisp and rich, this vibrant long black is cold brewed to bring out subtle sweet notes. In the evening it could be poured over ice-cream and liqueur for a cool take on an affogato. [\\$22 for 4 x 240ml, coffeesupreme.com](http://coffeesupreme.com)

INDUSTRY BEANS COLD BREW COFFEE

ALLPRESS ESPRESSO LATTE ICED

SINGLE O ICED LATTE PILOT CAN

BONDI CIRCUS LATTE

This micro-roastery steeps organic coffee in filtered water for around 16 hours before triple filtering it, resulting in a sweet and smooth brew. Made without heat and using oat milk, this can is ideal to crack on a warm summer morning. [\\$3.70 for 250ml, coles.com.au](http://coles.com.au)
