1954 – Newer Jeep Wrangler Tailgate Barrier Net Install (with mounting hardware kit option)

NOTE: Many newer models have B-pillar handles and even overhead on the ceiling that can be used for some of the top mounting locations. Check to see if you prefer to use these factory locations as the nets typically have enough adjustment to allow for this option. If your vehicle does not have handles in desired locations or you prefer to install mounting points for better fitment, please follow the below steps.

IMPORTANT: READ INSTRUCTIONS FULLY BEFORE STARTING

Time: About 15-30 minutes



Paw Level:

Tools: (may vary by vehicle)

1. Drill bit
2. Utility knife
3. 10 mm socket and driver
4. T-40 Torx and wrench

Installation shown in a TJ (duplicate procedure for other Jeep and similar vehicles).

NOTE: Check before drilling for hidden lines or obstructions.



Step 1

With the Torx, T-40 socket and wrench, remove existing OE bolt for the tailgate striker catch towards the rear of the Jeep.



Step 2

Install one of the square ring tabs onto the OE T-40 bolt and re-install oriented as shown.



Step 3

On opposite side of vehicle drill a pilot hole for the self-tapping bolt an equal distance as the OE T-40 bolt's location on the driver's side (about 4" in past vertical side of wheel well).

Step 4

Use the 10mm driver to install the SMS bolt and another square ring, oriented to inside as in previous steps. It's a good idea to treat the hole with some clear paint or sealant to resist corrosion inside and underneath the vehicle.



Step 5

Line up the carpet and carefully cut a slit to allow the square ring to extend above the carpet as detailed here.

Step 6

Continue installing additional mount points as required or as in this case on the TJ, existing mounts are supplied from the manufacturer on the floor. Feed the straps through the mounts and back into the cam buckles by squeezing the buckle's tab and inserting and pulling straps.

Wrap and tuck excess strap (the net can be used as a cargo net flat on the floor as required and it is adjustable)
