2006 & Older Jeep Wrangler Side Window Nets Install

NOTE: Many newer models have B-pillar handles and even overhead on the ceiling that can be used for some of the top mounting locations. Check to see if you prefer to use these factory locations as the nets typically have enough adjustment to allow for this option. If your vehicle does not have handles in desired locations or you prefer to install mounting points for better fitment, please follow the below steps.

The Raingler Side Window Nets are very easy to install and offer a couple different mounting options depending on your particular set up and other aftermarket and factory configurations.

Please contact us if you have any questions as we have done hundreds of installations on location. As Jeep owners and enthusiasts, we are very familiar with these vehicles and installation options that may be used as needed. The top can be left in place, but you will find it easier to install with hardtops removed and side soft tops windows and the top still in the up position.

Step 1

Make sure the Raingler label is facing outwards. This is easier to install if the side windows are out, but still doable if the top needs to stay on during installation.

Step 2

Start at the top of the net towards the front of the Jeep and wrap the strap diagonally around the roll bar and then back into the cam-buckle. Feed into buckle while depressing to expose the teeth inside the cam-buckle. Do not fully tighten yet. Repeat on other side.



Step 3

Wrap the lower straps around the side roll bars by the wheel well. Repeat this process for the other side, leaving the bottom straps for last.

Step 4

Tension and pull lower straps as to draw the bottom edge of the net very tight next to the wheel well.

Step 5

Tension and pull top straps to draw the net up off the wheel well surface as desired.

NOTE: 2" webbing versions have a middle set of straps that are tightened last.

Step 6
