## NETS & GRIPS

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### 2019 - newer Subaru Forester Behind Rear Seats Barrier(supplemental installation notes)

**Paw Level:**

**Tools: (may vary by vehicle)**

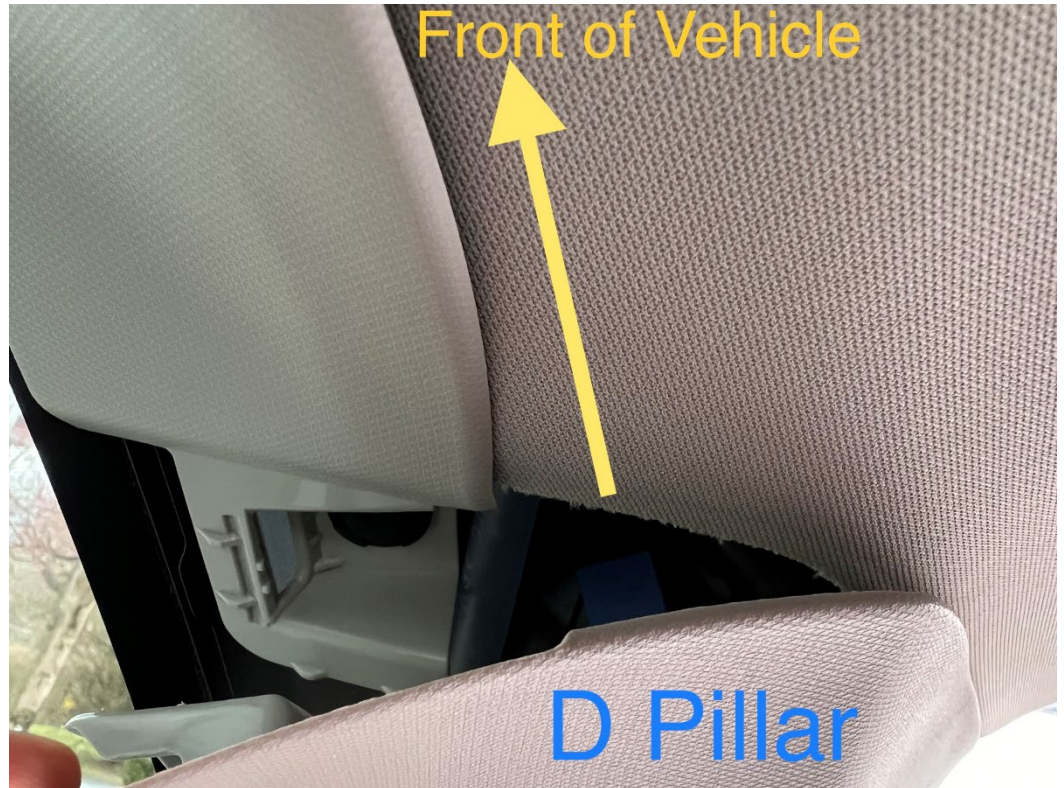
1. Ratchet
2. Panel Removal Tool
3. 10MM socket
4. 14MM socket
5. Phillips head

There is an additional clip that must be removed that is not shown in our installation video.

To remove the panel above the cargo window (the panel behind which the C100 is installed) the installer first needs to remove a clip that secures this panel to the D-pillar. Only then can the installer pull down on the panel above the window to remove it.

To gain access to this clip, the installer needs to first pull back the D-pillar panel. This is done by pulling the D-pillar panel away from the side window to release it.

You can see the clip in the bottom of the image here:



The clip is this style. It requires a tool (ideally a plastic trim puller) to remove the center part.

**When you get done, be sure to**

**Tie up the loose ends**

You can do this by feeding the end of the strap through the opening of the buckle to create a loop. Feed the strap through the loop, and the strap behind, continue until no strap is hanging.
