## NETS & GRIPS

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### 2021 - newer Subaru Outback and Wilderness Front Barrier (supplemental installation notes)

NOTE: Many newer models have B-pillar handles and even overhead on the ceiling that can be used for some of the top mounting locations. Check to see if you prefer to use these factory locations as the nets typically have enough adjustment to allow for this option. If your vehicle does not have handles in desired locations or you prefer to install mounting points for better fitment, please follow the below steps.

**Paw Level:**

1. Ratchet
2. Panel Removal Tool
3. 10MM socket
4. 14MM socket
5. Phillips head

## After Exterior Panel Removal (both upper and lower)

### Lower Mount:



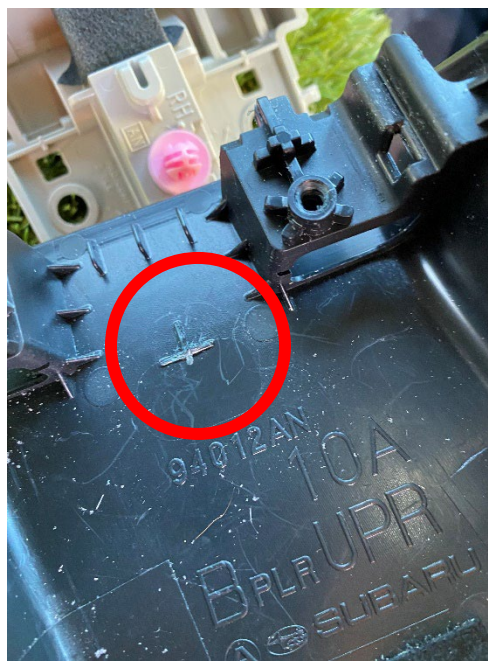
### Top Mount:



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The pro tip is to remove the gray piece from the b-pillar cover and cut off the plastic t-shaped post, which doesn't appear to do anything. Makes reassembly much easier.



The top C102 mount must be installed with the swivel facing up and then the black square loop oriented down. This is tight because the washer for the bolt presses on the swivel causing it to bind, but it does work. Route the strap down and up under the tan piece and it will come out between the tan and the black interior b-pillar piece. While holding the d-ring to keep it from falling back down, slide the plastic back up and reinstall into the chassis.



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**\*NOTE regarding upper seat belt slider:**

1) be careful with the spring and the tabs it connects to.

2) The tan plastic slider must sit under the black plastic ledge and the bolt head lines up with the bolt hole cutout.



### **Tie up the loose ends**

You can do this by feeding the end of the strap through the opening of the buckle to create a loop. Feed the strap through the loop, and the strap behind, continue until no strap is hanging.
