STRETCH FACTOR GUIDE:

1. PRINT OUT THE STRETCH FACTOR GUIDE:

Print out this simple stretch guide first. Make sure it's printed actual size. Do not scale.

2. CUT AND LABEL A FABRIC SWATCH:

Measure & cut a fabric sample 10cm x 10cm (3 7/8"), on the grain of the fabric. Don't include the actual selvage in your sample. Draw an arrow on your fabric to remind you which direction horizontal is.

3. DETERMINE HORIZONTAL STRETCH


Fold the fabric swatch in half, along the horizontal grain.

Hold fabric at left edge (A) of guide & stretch as far right as possible.

Note the % stretch factor it reaches on the guide.

4. VERTICAL STRETCH

Repeat Steps 3-5, this time folding the fabric in half along the vertical grain.
