Power ON and OFF

ON: Push switch to "I" position

OFF: Push switch to "O" position

Capacity Display (aka Fuel Gauge): There are four power indicator LEDs. Turn on the Power Bank and the stored power capacity will be displayed. If the Power Bank is turned ON and no indicator LEDs illuminate the Power Bank needs to be recharged.

Charging the Power Bank:

- 1. A complete charge takes approximately 6 hours
- 2. Connect the provided AC-DC charger to power socket (100-240V available)
- 3. Set the Power Bank to OFF
- 4. Connect the Power Bank to the AC-DC charger
- 5. Turn the Power Bank to ON
- 6. Note that on the AC-DC charger there is a LED displayed. Red indicates charging is taking place. When the Power Bank is fully charged the LED will turn Green. Note: The LED may also show green if the Power Bank is turned OFF when plugged in to the AC-DC charger.
- 7. The LED on the AC-DC charger will change from red to green when Power Bank reaches 95% power capacity.
- 8. Once the Power Bank is fully charged turn to OFF "O" preventing power consumption by the four power indicator LEDs.
- Using the provided AC-DC charger you can charge the Power Bank and power a StompLight Professional or StompLight DMX Slave Light using the included Power Splitter Cable
