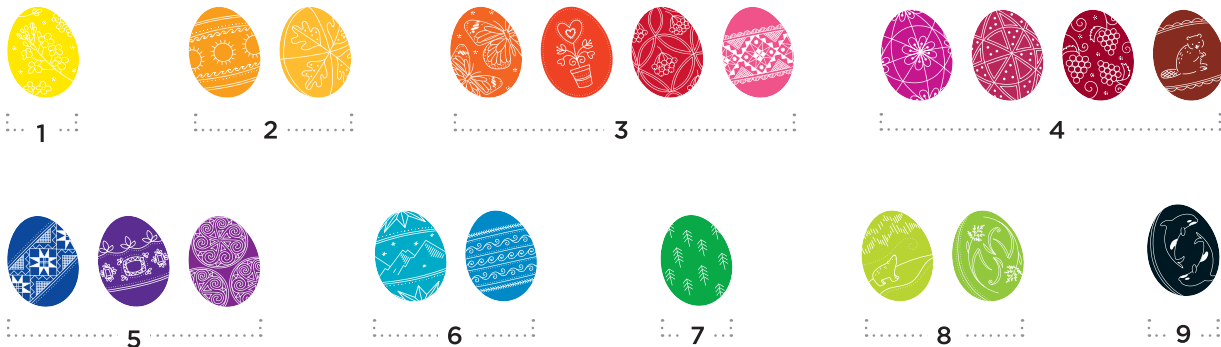

PROCEDURE

- **Normal sequence**
Dip into the desired dye colour.
- **Wash back**
Lightly wash with dishsoap and a soft toothbrush. Rinse well, dip in vinegar, allow to dry. Dip into desired colour.
- ◐ **Cleansing orange**
Roll the egg in cleansing orange until the colour is neutralized, then proceed to desired colour.
- ◑ **Try normal sequence.**
If that doesn't work, **wash back**.
- ◒ **Try cleansing orange.**
If that doesn't work, **wash back**.

COLOUR GROUPS

These groups correspond to the numbers on the “starting colour” and “desired results” axes.



TIPS

Washing back can affect the way the shell takes the dye. For best results, plan your design so it follows normal sequence.

Experiment! Don't be afraid to try dipping directly into the desired colour. You may be pleasantly surprised by the result!

Take notes. You'll soon learn what works and what doesn't.
