

- 1. Print the template on cardstock or thick paper.
- 2. Choose the colors of your transparent kite paper or tissue paper.
- 3. Lay your transparent paper over the template and trace the spaces you plan to fill in with paper. Use the dotted lines as guides for the grass, sky and sun. Remember each color needs to overlap slightly so leave extra margin.
- 4. Use a craft knife or X-acto blade to cut out negative space in the template above, including the dotted lines.
- 5. Line up and glue each piece of paper into place, overlapping them slightly where they meet. Get creative and add layers of smaller pieces to create more a dynamic transparency.
