Front Inner Fenders

2021+ FORD BRONCO **INFEND-05FB**



TOOLS REQUIRED

- Ratchet
- #4 Allen Head
- 11/32" Drill Bit
- Drill
- Nutsert Tool (M6)
- Philips Head Screwdriver

SKILL LEVEL

- Novice/Intermediate -1 (you) to 2 persons

Little skill level required, you can easily install it by yourself however, additional help will be useful

TIME REQUIRED

- 3 Hours

Time to install this should only take about 3 hours

STEP 1

You will need to fully remove the front fenders by turning the clips on the underside of the fender down until they feel loose. Once loose, pull the fender away from the Bronco directly towards you, releasing the clips.

Note: Both front and rear fenders are mounted in this manner.

Tools Required: Philips Head Screw Driver Panel Clip Removal Tool









STEP 2


Use a philips head screw driver and panel clip removal tool to remove the clips along the lip of the fender and the section closest to the engine bay.

Note: Check along the inner fender where it meets wheel well thoroughly. They are easy to miss.

Tools Required: Philips Head Screw Driver Panel Clip Removal Tool

STEP 3

Remove the inner fender by pulling down onit near the lip of the fender, and thenout.





STEP 1

Begin by unpacking all items and inspecting for missing pieces or damage. If you have any concerns, please contact the company the product was purchased from.

Hardware Included: (24) M6x20 (37) M6x14 (37) M6 Serrated Nuts (24) M6 Nutserts




STEP 2

Assemble the piece A and B using a #4 allen head using the provided M6x20 and a #4 allen head.

Note: Ensure mesh is secure before installation. If you want to paint the mesh, It is recommended before installation.







STEP 3

Install piece C to the assembly, noting the orientation of piece C in reference to the assembly.



STEP 4

Install Piece D to the assembly, noting the orientation of piece D in reference to the assembly.



STEP 5

Install piece E to the assembly, noting the orientation of piece E in reference to the assembly.





STEP 6

Bend back the mounting tabs that will not be used for installation (From the front, this will be the 1st and 5th). The remaining tabs can be adjusted by hand to better line up with the DV8 inner fender during installation. If you are unsure of which tabs to bend, you can gently maneuver the inner fender into the wheel well, and reference the holes on the inner fender with the mounting tabs.

STEP 7

On the passenger side of the vehicle and additional bracket will be installed using a christmas tree clip that will be taken from the stock inner fender.









STEP 8

Drill out the holes in the remaining tabs with 11/32" drill bit and install nutserts using a nutsert tool.







STEP 9


Maneuver the inner fender into the wheel well carefully so as not to damage the inner fender. It may take a few attempts to get it correct.

Install the DV8 inner fenders using a #4 allen head and provided M6x14 hardware.

Note: The passenger side has slightly different mounting points on inner fender where the additional bracket is installed.









STEP 10

Double check fitment and all hardware is secure. Repeat steps for other side.
