## WITH A SAMPLE RING

Select a ring that fits the intended finger and place it on top of the circles below, matching the inside diameter of the ring to the circle nearest in size. If you don't have a printer, visit Jewelry Wise and follow the on screen instructions to find your size.

## WITHOUT A SAMPLE RING

Wrap a measuring tape or thin paper strip around the intended finger, mark it and measure it with a ruler. Match your measurement to the chart above for your ring size. If it falls between sizes, order a size up.

## TIP FOR THE MEN

If you're buying a surprise gift, ask your lady's mother or close friend if they know her ring size. Or, borrow a ring which she wears on the correct finger and use the chart above to find her size.

## IMPORTANT!



Ring measurements are very precise to ensure you have the most comfortable fit. To do so, set the page scaling to "none" on your print dialog box then print this page in A4 paper size. To confirm the scale, measure the bar on the left. It must be exactly 40 mm long.
