Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

12-107.1

(A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, A PERSON WHO PURCHASES AT A LICENSED PREMISES A MEAL AND A BOTTLE OF WINE, THE CONTENTS OF WHICH ARE PARTIALLY CONSUMED WITH THE MEAL, MAY REMOVE THE BOTTLE AND ITS CONTENTS FROM THE LICENSED PREMISES IF THE LICENSE HOLDER OR AN EMPLOYEE OF THE LICENSE HOLDER INSERTS A CORK IN THE BOTTLE SO THAT THE TOP OF THE CORK IS LEVEL WITH THE LIP OF OR PLACES A CAP ON THE BOTTLE.
