

## Handprint Frog

### Materials:

Construction Paper, assorted colors

Scissors

Glue

Marker or crayons



### Instructions:

Cut out a large circle from construction paper for the frog's body. (Tip: use a paper plate or coffee can to trace circle.)

Trace handprints on another sheet of construction paper and cut out to make feet for the frog. Glue to the circle with thumbs facing each other.

For the eyes, cut ovals about the size of an egg from construction paper. Glue one end of each oval to the circle opposite the feet. Use a marker or crayon to draw half-circles on each of the ovals.

Use markers or crayons to add a mouth and other details to your frog.

For the tongue, cut a thin strip of paper from construction paper. Curl the paper around a pencil to give the tongue shape. Glue one end of the tongue to the frog's mouth.
