Safety Instructions

- 1. Do not direct steam at people, animals, or at electrical outlets.
- 2. Do not expose the appliance to rain.
- 3. Only use and store the appliance indoors.
- Unplug from power outlet when not in use and before conducting maintenance or troubleshooting.
- 5. Do not leave the appliance unattended when powered.
- Do not expose hair, loose clothing, fingers or body parts to openings or moving parts.
- 7. Do not clean or service the appliance when it is plugged in.
- 8. Do not handle the appliance with wet hands.
- Do not use appliance if it has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors or dropped into water contact Swan Customer Service: https://www.swan-brand.co.uk/support.
- 10. Do not pull or carry the appliance by the power cord, use the cord as a handle, close a door on the cord, pull cord around sharp corners or edges, or expose cord to heated surfaces.
- 11. Do not unplug the appliance by pulling on the cord.
- 12. Do not use appliance in an enclosed space filled with vapour given off by oil-based paint thinner, some moth proofing sub-stances, flammable dust, or other explosive or toxic vapours.
- 13. Do not allow the appliance to be used as a toy.
- 14. Do not use on leather, wax polished furniture or floors, synthetic fabrics, wall coverings, velvet or other delicate, steam-sensitive materials.
- 15. Do not immerse the appliance in water.
- 16. Not for space heating purposes.
- 17. Do not use for any purpose other than described in this User's Guide.
- 18. NEVER put descaling, aromatic, alcohol or detergent products into the steam cleaner, as this may damage it or make it unsafe for use.





Safety Instructions

When using any electrical appliance, basic safety precautions should always be followed including the following:

- Always ensure that the voltage on the rating label corresponds to the mains voltage in your home.
- Incorrect operation and improper use can damage the appliance and cause injury to the user.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and if they understand the hazards involved. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children unless they are older than 8 and supervised. Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children aged less than 8 years.
- Appliances can be used by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- Check the power cord and plug regularly for any damage. If the cord or the plug is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or qualified person in order to avoid an electrical hazard.

- Do not use the appliance if it has been dropped or damaged in any way. In case of damage, take the unit in for examination and/or repair by an authorised service agent.
- Never immerse the unit in water or any other liquid for cleaning purposes.
- Remove the plug from the socket by gripping the plug. Do not pull on the cord to disconnect the appliance from the mains. Always unplug the unit when not in use, before cleaning, when filling or emptying the tank or adding/ removing parts.
- The use of accessory attachments that are not recommended or supplied by the manufacturer may result in injuries, fire or electric shock.
- Do not let the cord hang over the edge of a table or counter.
 Ensure that the cord is not in a position where it can be pulled on inadvertently.
- Do not allow the cord to touch hot surfaces and do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner or in a heated oven.








Safety Instructions

- Use of an extension cord with this appliance is not recommended.
 However, if it is necessary to use an extension lead, ensure that the lead is suited to the power consumption of the appliance to avoid overheating of the extension cord, appliance or plug point. Do not place the extension cord in a position where it can be pulled on by children or animals or tripped over.
- This appliance is not suitable for outdoor use.
- Do not use the appliance for anything other than its intended use.
- Do not carry the appliance by the power cord.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended during use. Always unplug the unit when not in use or before cleaning.
- Always operate the appliance on a smooth, even, stable surface. Do not place the unit on a hot surface.
- Ensure that the unit is switched off after use.
- The manufacturer does not accept responsibility for any damage or injury caused by improper or incorrect use, or for repairs carried out by unauthorised personnel.

- In case of technical problems, switch off the product and do not attempt to repair it yourself. Return the appliance to an authorised service facility for examination, adjustment or repair. Always insist on the use of original spare parts. Failure to comply with the above mentions, precautions and instructions, could affect the safe operation of this product.
- Don't use the appliance with incorrect voltage as this may result in damage or injury to the user. The correct voltage is listed on the rating label.
- Use only CE marked 13 amp extension cords, non-approved extension cords may overheat.
 Care should be taken to arrange the extension cord as it can be a trip hazard.
- Store the appliance in a cool, dry area.
- Your appliance must never be switched on through an external timer or any kind of separate remote-control system.
- Do not fill past the MAX level.






- 1 Attach the lower body to the mop head by pushing onto the pipe and snapping it into place.
- 2. Insert the metal tube into the upper part of the main body pushing until it locks into place.
- 3 Install the water tank below the lower part of the main body.
- 4. Your Steam Mop body assembly is now complete.

Removable Water Tank

The water tank is located at the bottom of the main body. It is recommended to use distilled or de-mineralised water in place of tap water to help increase the lifespan of your steam mop. Make sure to observe the minimum / maximum level markers on any liquid container.

Press the tabs on either side of the tank and pull away to release from the main body.





Please Note:


- Make sure to turn off the steam mop when taking the water tank off the main body.
- Fill the water tank with the supplied water cup.





Steam Control

The Steam Control indicator light (2) will stop blinking when steam mop is ready to use. Once the light is solid, press the Steam Control Button (1) to choose the level of steam you desire.



Please Note:

Press the power switch first and then press the steam control. Also note, that when you first press the steam level button the steam power is at its maximum level. Adjust the steam to your desired level by pressing the button.

Before First use

Remove all stickers and protective covers from the appliance and unwind the power cord.

Inspect for damage and contact our help line if any is found.

Check with the floor-covering provider to ensure that steam cleaning is appropriate.

If in any doubt, then test on a small inconspicuous area first and let it dry before judging.


Thoroughly sweep or vacuum floor prior to cleaning with the steam mop.





Microfibre Mop Pads

The re-usable microfibre mop pads are machine washable and safe for virtually all hard floor surfaces.



The mop pad has Velcro panels affixed which will allow you to easily place it into place. Once the pad is fitted, snap on the holding frame, this will keep the pad secure as you clean your surface. To remove the frame simply pull the quick-grip release tab, taking care not to use too much force, and push down.

The mop pad may have already come attached to the mop head.




Filling the Water Tank

- Set the mop head into mop pad, making sure quick-grip release tab is located at the back
- 2. Take the water tank out.
 - a. Press the tabs on both sides of the tank and carefully pull it out.
 - b. Pull out the rubber plug on the back of the tank.
 - c. Fill water tank with water and replace the plug. For best results the water should be at room temperature.
 - d. Replace the water tank by gently sliding it securely into place. The tank will click once docked correctly.
- 3. Unwrap the power cord and insert the plug into the mains socket.
- 4. The indicator will light up when the steam mop is ready to use. Press the steam level button to select the steam level you want.

Please Note:

Upon first use of the steam mop or first use after refilling the water tank, the pump may make a "knocking" sound. This is normal and should only last a few seconds.




How to Use

Cleaning Hard Floors

Your steam mop is designed to clean hard flooring such as ceramic tile, vinyl, laminate, marble, stone and sealed hard wood floors. Use of your steam mop on waxed or some unwaxed floors may result in a diminished glossiness.

 Plug the unit in and wait 30 seconds for it to heat up. Choose the level of steam to clean your floor: Low (delicate floors). Medium (regular cleaning). High (durable floors or sticky messes). Begin cleaning by slowly passing the unit over the floor surface.



Please Note:

Press power switch before you press steam control. When you first press the steam level button, the steam is at its maximum level. Please adjust desired level by pressing the button.

- To turn off the steam mop press the power switch.
- Light is illuminated above the steam level button.
- When the steam mop stops emitting steam, unplug the unit. Simply remove the water tank, refill and continue steaming.
- Be sure to disinfect the floor, use a microfibre mat and wipe it back and clean it after each use.






How to Use

Carpet Glider

This accessory is attached to the steam mop to allow it to slide over the carpet with ease.

Please Note:

- Please make sure that carpet ailder has been fixed onto the floor head. If it is not in the correct position, it will cause carpet gilder to fall out during use.
- Move the steam mop in a continuous motion until you are finished. DO NOT leave the mop in a stationary position.



Descaling

As with all appliances using water there is a requirement to descale the Steam Mop. The period between descales will depend upon the water you choose to use. In a hard water area this could be after 2 - 3 uses and if using bottled or filtered water this could be multiple uses.

To descale: Mix 100 ml of white vinegar with 1 litre of bottled or filtered water and add to the tank, Leave to soak for 1 - 3 hours. Preheat the mop and select Maximum Steam setting. Hold the mop over a sink or other suitable area and allow the steam to emit until the tank is empty.

Unplug the mop and refill the tank with water and repeat the steps above.



Care and Maintenance

Any water remaining in the water tank should be fully emptied prior to storing the Steam Mop.

Replace the filter every three months (soft water can affect its quality and large particles of impurities may be filtered into the pump).

Make sure the water tank is empty when the appliance is not in use.

Troubleshooting

WARNING

To reduce the risk of electric shock, turn power switch off and disconnect the plug form electrical outlet before performing maintenance or troubleshooting checks.

Problems	Possible Reasons	Solutions
Reduced steam or no steam.	Water tank empty. Incorrect Steam level selected. Limescale blockage.	Fill tank. Select steam level by pushing steam level button. Follow descale procedure.
Water leakage.	Loosened rubber plug.	Turn off the cleaner and pull out the water tank. Fit the rubber plug tightly.
Scale deposit.	Tap water or chemicals used?	Use bottled or filtered water. Follow descale procedure.
Hard to use on the carpet.	Carpet glider not securely attached.	Make sure the carpet glider has been fixed onto the floor head correctly.
Water tank rusts.	Tank has been left with water inside when not in use.	Any water remaining in the water tank should be emptied prior to storing the Steam Mop.
Mop getting hot.	Wrong steam level.	When you first press the steam level button, the steam is at its maximum level. Please adjust desired level by pressing the button.





Troubleshooting

Problems	Possible Reasons	Solutions
Mop getting too wet.	Leaving the mop in a stationary position while in use.	Move the steam mop in a continuous motion until you are finished.
Stops working.	Improper operation or product problem.	Contact SWAN at https:// www.swan-brand.co.uk/ support
