When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING THIS VACUUM CLEANER

Failure to follow the warnings and instructions may result in electric shock, fire and/or serious injury.

WARNING

This vacuum cleaner is intended for household use only and NOT for commercial or industrial use.

- Only use the vacuum cleaner indoors on dry surfaces and keep the area you're cleaning well lit.
- Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from moving parts and openings whilst using the vacuum cleaner.
- Use only Eureka | Swan recommended tools and accessories with this vacuum cleaner.
- Don't use the vacuum cleaner if it has been dropped, damaged or left outdoors.
- Don't run over the power cord or use the vacuum cleaner if the power cord or plug is damaged.
- Don't handle the plug or use the vacuum cleaner with wet hands.
- Don't pull or carry the vacuum cleaner by the power cord.
- Don't use the power cord as a handle, pull the power cord around corners, sharp edges or close a door over the power cord.
- Don't unplug vacuum cleaner by pulling on the power cord.
- Turn off all controls on the vacuum cleaner before disconnecting or connecting the power cord.
- Always make sure the filters are in place before use.
- Always switch off the vacuum cleaner before disconnecting or connecting the hose and accessories.
- Keep all openings clear and free from debris as this may affect the air flow/suction.
- Always replace the fuse in the plug with a British 13 amp fuse.









IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

- Always protect the power cable from heated surfaces and open flames.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the vacuum cleaner in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the vacuum cleaner. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- Don't vacuum up any flammable or combustible materials (lighter fluid, petrol, kerosene etc.) or use the vacuum cleaner in an area with explosive vapours or liquid.
- Don't vacuum up hot coals, cigarette butts, matches or smoking hot, burning items or use in an area where there may be harmful fluids (chlorine, bleach, and ammonia drain cleaner).
- Don't attempt to remove blockages with sharp objects as this may cause damage to the vacuum cleaner.
- Don't vacuum up hard or sharp objects such as glass, nails, screws or coins etc.
- Don't use the vacuum cleaner with incorrect voltage as this may result in damage or injury to the user. The correct voltage is listed on the rating label.
- Take extra care when positioning and using the vacuum cleaner on the stairs.
- Use only CE marked 13 amp extension cords, non-approved extension cords may overheat. Care should be taken to arrange the extension cord as it can be a trip hazard.
- Store the vacuum cleaner in a cool, dry area. If filters have been cleaned as per user guide instructions ensure they are thoroughly dry before storing away.

/ Make sure your vacuum cleaner is switched off and unplugged when cleaning, removing or refitting parts.







DO NOT plug in your vacuum cleaner until you have completely assembled it per the following instructions and are familiar with all instructions and operation procedures.




Remove the dust tank before installing handle. Insert the handle into the vacuum body, then rotate the screw into body as shown. IMPORTANT: The handle must be it clicks into place. inserted first before replacing dust tank



Place the dust tank back onto the machine and push until



Insert the handle hose end into the conector hose and rotate clockwise to join. Then insert the handle into the other hose of the body.




Insert the 3-in-1 crevice tool accessory into the on-board storage reservoir, as shown.







OPERATION




Twist the quick release cord hook to release the power cord.



Step on the brush cover and pull back on handle, to engage for operation.



Plug in your machine and push ON/OFF button to switch ON/OFF.



To maintain optimal performance, please emtpy dust tank when debris reaches MAX FILL line.







The 3-in-1 crevice tool with brush allows for vacuuming in narrow and hard-to-reach places.





For vacuuming pet hair from surfaces










The handle hose can be used immediately.


Emptying and cleaning the dust tank



Press dust tank release button to remove the dust tank.




Hold dust tankover rubbish bin and unclip the lock on the bottom of the tank, allowing the dust to empty.



Close the base of the dust tank align the tank base back onto the machine and push until it clicks back into place.

MARNING

If the filter or hose is clogged, the motor may shut down in order to protect itself from overheating. If this occurs, unplug the vacuum, clean the filter and inspect the hoses and canister for clogging. Allow 3-4 hours for the unit to fully cool down before resuming use.




Inspect the lower tube and nozzle and remove the dirt and debris.

 \triangle **WARNING:** Turn off and unplug vacuum cleaner before performing maintenance to the vacuum cleaner.



Locate and unlock filter cover as shown. Push left to un-lock, right to lock



Remove filter cover with filter. Wipe with cloth over rubbish bin, removing dirt and debris.



Wash with water every 3 months, allow at least 24 hours to dry and make sure it is dry thoroughly before re-using

DUST TANK



1. Remove the dust tank.



2. Push the release button, open the dust tank and clean all parts of the dust tank



3. Open the dust tank filter lid located on top tank foam filter. of the tank



4. Remove the dust





5. Hand wash the foam filter..



6. Allow filter to dry before putting back info vacuum cleaner




7. Twist filter assembly anti-clockwise to remove for cleaning dirt and debris as needed.

DO NOT operate without filter installed **DO NOT** wash dust tank in the dish washer **DO NOT** install filter if it is damp

△ CAUTION:

Do not turn the appliance on when the dust tank is removed. In order to keep the suction force optimised, the dust tank and filters must be cleaned regularly.

CLEANING BRUSH ROLL

Carefully remove any string, hair or debris located on the brush roll.

You can use a tool such as a small knife or scissors to remove and cut any hair or string.






MAINTENANCE

Pet Tool (SC15832N, SC15834N only)



1. To release the pet tool plastic upper cap for internal cleaning, roatate, unlock and remove the plastic locking ring as shown.



2. Pull up on the plastic upper cap of the pet tool as shown.



3. Remove plastic upper cap and clean, removing pet hair and debris.

- Do not clean the vacuum cleaner, components or accessories using petrol or any other flammable liquid or solvents, etc.
- Clean only the outside of the vacuum cleaner.
- Use only a moist cloth and mild detergent for cleaning the vacuum cleaner, components and accessories.
- After cleaning, wipe off the moisture on vacuum cleaner, components and accessories with a dry cloth.
- Do Not place accessories, tools or components in a dishwasher.

Bush Roll

You should check your cleaner's brush roll and drive belt regularly for wear or damage. You should also clean the brush and brush ends by removing string, hair and carpet fibres. These can wrap around the brush and hamper its ability to effectively clean your carpet. Also remove any debris that has accumulated under the brush cover.

- 1. Turn off vacuum and unplug from electrical outlet.
- 2. Place vacuum upside down with brush roll facing upwards.
- 3. Remove the six screws as shown with a small Phillips screwdriver (see images below).
- 4. Lift off brush cover.
- 5. Grasp floor brush at both ends and remove by lifting out.
- 6. Clean string, hair and other debris from floor brush, motor pulley, and drive belt.
- 7. Check floor brush for worn areas and replace if needed.
- 8. Check air passageway for obstructions. Remove debris from this area.
- When finished cleaning, reposition floor brush and drive belt. Then replace the brush cover and re-install the six screws.
- 10. Turn floor brush by hand several times in the direction of the motor pulley. If properly installed, the drive belt will align itself on floor brush.












Replacing The Drive Belt

Make sure the vacuum is switched off and unplugged first


Check the drive belt carefully for wear, cuts and stressed areas. If the drive belt appears worn, you will need to replace it. To remove the drive belt, read the instructions and follow the drawings below:


- 1. Grasp the old drive belt and remove from motor shaft. Discard old drive belt.
- 2. Loop new drive belt over motor shaft and stretch other end over floor brush in the space provided between the bristles.
- 3. Place ends of floor brush down into slots on sides as shown.
- 4. Turn floor brush by hand several times in the direction of the motor shaft.
- 5. If properly installed, drive belt will align itself on floor brush.
- 6. Replace brush cover and six screws.





