



Fusing Powder Enamels Assortment

Create vibrant art with 80 mesh enamel powders. Set includes opaque and transparent colors, each in a zipper top bag. Compatible with most fusible glass, colors have teen tested for use with 90 COE and 96 COE.

Enamel colors mature when fused between is 1250° - 1450° F

Ideas for application of enamels:

- · Use a sifter to apply enamels
- · Create a distinct design by using a stencil
- · Paint designs by mixing enamels with a liquid medium such as Klyr Fire
- · Write or draw enamel designs using an applicator bottle by mixing enamel powder with powdered clear frit and liquid stringer medium

Always wear an appropriate particulate mask when handling powders.

Bags are individually labeled to identify colors.

The final color of fired enamels can be influenced by how much enamel is deposited on the glass, and by the color of the base glass. Apply colors to white, clear or a light color glass for the most vibrant results.
