About Us

Grounds for Change is passionate about operating as a green business and we recently received a Washington award for Outstanding Achievement in Sustainability. We are a member of *1% for the Planet* and donate well over 1% of our total sales to various social and environmental organizations. This year, our donations helped to support a local elementary school's environmental stewardship program, advocate for migratory songbirds impacted by coffee cultivation, restore salmon habitat, and support a collective of women coffee producers and their families in Peru and Mexico.

We recycle all of our burlap coffee bags by donating them to local organic farmers to be used as weed barriers and erosion control. All of the chaff by-product of the roasting process goes to local farmers for use as fertilizer on their organic farms. The spent coffee grounds produced by our brewers go to local blueberry farms to be used as compost. We offset 100% of our carbon dioxide emissions (CarbonFree® Certified Product) and purchase only Green Power.
