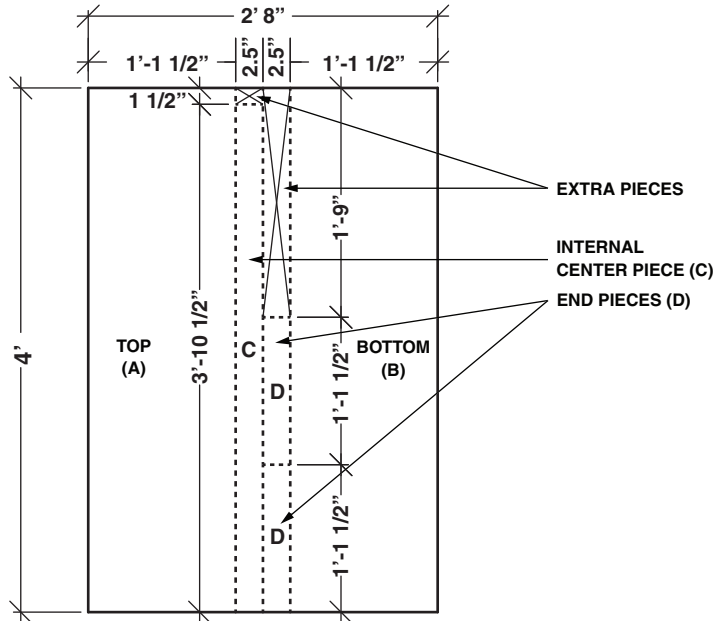

CUT SHEET DIMENSIONS

MATERIALS:

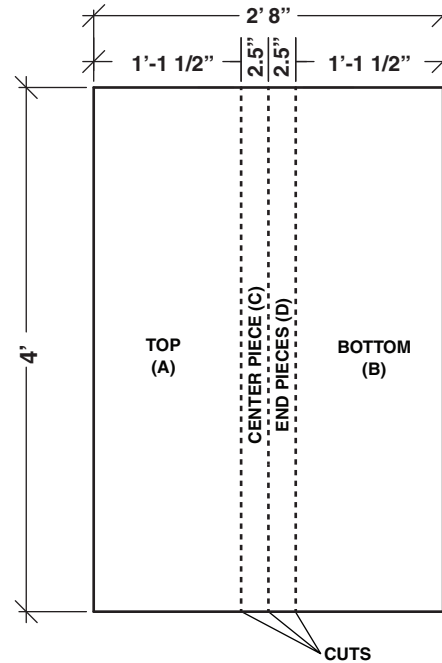
1/3 sheet of a 3/4" thick sheet of plywood (2'-8" x 4').

NOTES:

Any lumber yard will be able to make the marked cuts for a few bucks.

It's important to cut the thin strips (C and D) out of the middle of the plywood to ensure that the parts are the same dimensions.

Once cut, make sure A & B are the same dimensions. Make sure the 2 (D) end pieces are the same dimension. Sand as needed to get pieces to match.



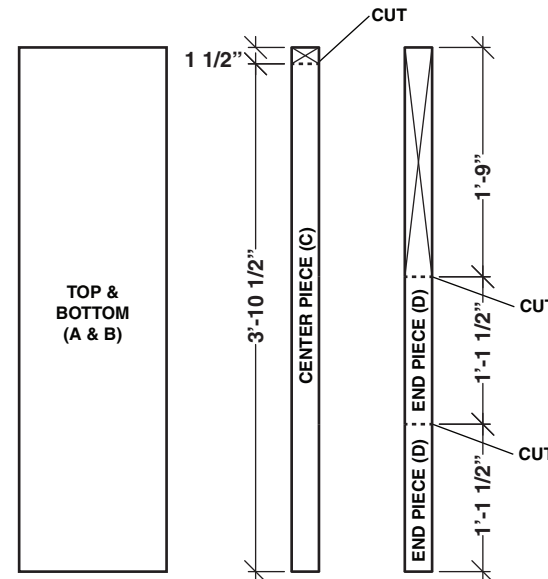
1: RIP CUTS

Start with a 1/3 sheet of 3/4" thick plywood sheet (2'-8" x 4').

Make the (3) RIP CUTS as noted.

Note:

Make sure the 2 thin strips (C and D) are cut out of the middle of the sheet, to make sure the parts are equal in height (C and D) and equal in width (A and B).



2: CROSS CUTS

Take the 2 thin center strips that you just ripped (C and D), and make the (3) CROSS CUTS as noted.

Set the top and bottom pieces (A and B) and make sure they are the same dimensions.

Note:

It's important that the 2 end pieces (D) are the same length.
