College students, baby gifts, wedding shower gifts and hometown heroes ensure their memories are treasured within the Life Chest. As a special gift in the living room at Christmas time or in a hospital room, these chests liter-Ily create conversation and memories.

Weterans find themselves wanting to be remembered before and after tours of duty. Families are brought closer during their time apart by sharing the keepsakes within the chest.

Amazing events happen to people with a mindset of unlimited possibilities. One such event happened when Donna was standing in line buying coffee in South Carolina near Ft. Bragg where she met Mike Elliott, the president and founder of the All Veteran Parachute Team (allveterantroup.com). Becoming friends they shared their mutual ideas. Mike Elliott described his mission to bring attention to the wounded soldiers who are dealing with PTSD. "Twenty-four veterans with PTSD commit suicide daily," he stated somberly.

His biography states that "With over 9,000 skydives as a U.S. Army Golden Knight, Mike Elliott is the master of the sky and considered to be the world's #1

paratrooper." Elliott has taken President George W. Bush sky diving on his 80th, 85th and 90th birthdays. On his 90th birthday, the senior Bush was presented with his own Life Chest after his successful jump with Mike. Referring to the Life Chest as "the most soulful product on the planet, because it's about our souls," Mike has pledged his help, the help of 100 volunteers, and 250 Life Chests to be given to veterans with combat-related disabilities. Recently, Donna was taken on a jump with Mike guiding her every foot of the way. Flashing her trademark smile, she infused everyone around her with her joy.

Donna states in her biography, Pumptitude, "Did I know I would be jumping out of a plane to bring awareness to the world about the soldiers who have sacrificed so much for our freedom? Definitely not, just as I could not have imagined how powerful it would be to attend conferences and hear the fears and triumphs of young women, men and children fighting for their lives as they battle cancer."

She goes on to say, "When I dream, I dream big. And when I decided to take on The Life Chest it was no different. The faith I have that there is a heartfelt purpose behind The Life Chest leads me every day."
