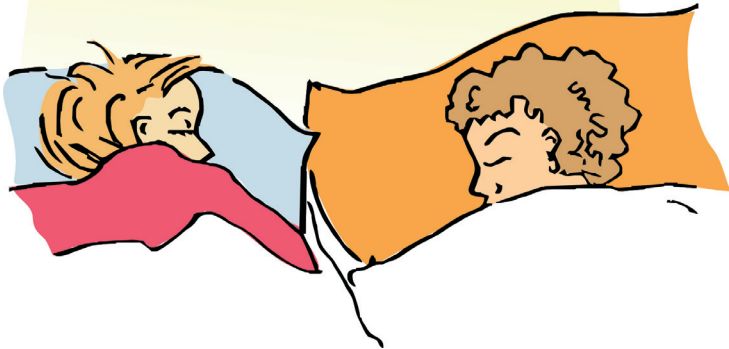

BEFORE YOU READ:

SIGHT WORDS:

1. Review all the sight words learned to this point, including color and number words.
2. There are no new sounds or sight words to learn before reading this book.

SOUNDS:

1. Review the digraph SH. This digraph will figure prominently in *Ned and Ted*. Practice sounding and writing words using this digraph: shop, ship, shut, fish, wish, dish, dash, bash, gush, hush.
2. The word family in this book is, of course, ED. Words in the story that belong in that family: Ned, Ted, bed, led, fed, red. Add to those: sled, shed, Fred, sled, bled, Jed, pled, wed.

READ:

Ned and Ted and then dictate short sentences from the book for the child to write.
