## **BEFORE YOU READ:**

(All SnapWords® resources are available at child1st.com)

SOUND SPELLINGS: /S/ spelled SC. Words: SCILLY, SCYTHES, SCIMITARS, SCENT, ASCEND, CRESCENT, DESCEND, MUSCLES, SCENERY. SCILLY is a group of tiny islands off England's southwest coast. ASCEND means to go up, while DESCEND means to go down. Refer to the pictures in the story for SCYTHE and SCIMITAR. SCYTHES has a Y that sounds like Long I. SCIMITARS has a Bossy R spelling AR that sounds like ER. SCENERY has a Bossy R spelling ER. MUSCLES has the LE spelling for /L/.

SNAPWORDS®: D Words: BUY. G Words: ALTHOUGH, BEAUTIFUL. BUY has two sounds: B and /I/ which is spelled UY. Rely on SnapWords® card for BUY because of the lack of other words with that spelling pattern. ALTHOUGH is one of the OUGH words. It sounds like ALL THO, which means OUGH /O/. The other word that shares the spelling pattern is "though." BEAUTIFUL has "be" and then /U/ spelled AU, TI, FUL. The A sneaks in there not doing much of anything. Use SnapWords® card for this word also.
