In September, we returned to Tetteh Quarshie Hospital in Ghana for the 3rd time. There, we performed 48 surgeries, gave daily lectures to local residents, and celebrated the opening of their palliative care ward. In October, we returned to Clinica Madre de Cristo in Trujillo Peru where we performed 60 surgeries in 4 days in addition to visiting Alta Trujillo and a local trauma center.
