WINEMAKING NOTES

The vines on the estate were planted in 1996 on a shallow, lateritic gravel ridge, with a south-west aspect. The fruit was handpicked and whole bunch pressed at 5°C directly to 50% new and 50% seasoned French oak puncheons. With the addition of wild yeast, a natural fermentation was allowed to occur. This wine was then aged within those same puncheons on lees with monthly stirring before being blended and lightly fined and filtered prior to bottling in December 2019.

TASTING NOTES

Colour	Pale straw with lemon hues. Bright and brilliant.
Aroma	White flower and ginger snap, toasty almond and nougat notes with a lift of fresh orange
	blossom.
Palate	Dry, fresh white stone fruit and apricots with toasted nut notes lead the chalky, textural palate. A touch of minerality means this wine exudes elegance with a long, silky persistent and balanced finish.
