## EXPERIENCE THE HALO BOARD!

**Congratulations** on your new Halo Board. Shortly you will experience what it feels like to enter a new dimension of riding never before thought possible. The Halo Board is said to give you a space-like feeling after learning how to properly ride the board. We have incorporated the safest and most effective battery technology to bring the Halo Board to life.

Before using, please read the entire manual in order to stay safe while you experience your new Halo Board. The manual covers important safety and performance tips.

### GENERAL WARNINGS

Like any sport, the Halo Board carries a risk of injury. By choosing to ride a Halo Board, you assume all responsibility for any risk. It is important that you understand safe riding practices to reduce the risk of injury. Because it is impossible to anticipate every situation and condition, this manual makes no claim to represent the safe use of the Halo Board under all conditions. There is a risk when using any electric board and the rider assumes all responsibility. Wear safety gear at all times while riding the Halo Board.

**When you ride the Halo Board you risk injury or death from loss of control, collisions, and falls. To ride safely, please review this manual thoroughly. Wear protective gear at all times!**

- Maximum rider weight: 120 kg
- Adult supervision is required for children under the age of 13
- Safety gear is required at all times

**Special note to parents and guardians:** As a parent or guardian, you are responsible for the activities and safety of your minor or child. For children 13 years of age and younger adult supervision is required. It is your responsibility to ensure that the Halo Board is maintained in a safe operating condition and that your child understands its proper use. It is also important that you and your child learn and obey local motor vehicle and traffic laws, and always wear proper protective gear (helmet, elbow and wrist guards).

# 1 SAFETY FIRST

---

Whether you are a pro or beginner, it's always safety first.

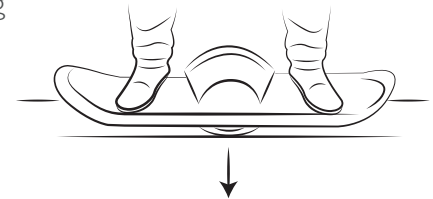
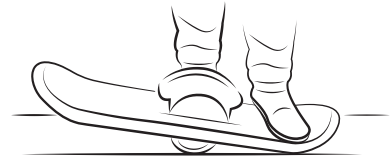
- DO NOT USE INDOORS. The motor is powerful and can tear up carpet and damage wood floors.
- Protective clothing is required at all times.
- Avoid crowded places or slippery roads.
- Always wear an approved helmet when riding your Halo Board.
- Be sure to attach the chinstrap and follow the helmet manufacturer's instructions.
- Wrist guards, elbow pads, and knee pads are required for extra protection.
- Always wear shoes that will stay on your feet and grip the Halo Board.
- Never ride barefoot or wearing flip-flops.

## 2 RIDE YOUR HALO BOARD

---

It is time to experience the joy of riding the Halo Board.

- Start your Halo Board setting it on the ground and pressing the power button on the side.
- Face the Halo Board and place your back foot on the foot pad that is on the lower side that is touching the ground. It is recommended to place your hands on the shoulders of a friend initially for balancing.
- Place your other foot on the foot pad on the front and slowly come up to balance the board.
- Use light and continuous pressure on the front pad until you are horizontal to the ground.
- Lean forward to slightly accelerate; remove pressure from the front pad (lean back) to slow down. Keep your legs straight (like you are standing on the ground) with a slight bend at your knees.
- To dismount the Halo Board, once you have come to a complete stop, lower the side of the board that your toes are facing completely to the ground, then step forward off the board.



## 3 CHARGING

---

Use only the provided charger to charge your Halo Board. Connect the charger to an “AC” supply and then to the Halo Board charging port. The Halo Board will be fully charged in approximately one hour.

Never leave the charge plugged in for more than 2 hours.

The indicator on the charging adapter will be red during charging, and turn green once fully charged.

Battery Indicator – The battery indicator on top of the board will show a fully set of LED bars when the battery is at least 85% charged. When it falls below 85%, the bars will begin to decrease.

## 4 BLUETOOTH

---

Your Halo Board comes with built-in Bluetooth to play your favorite music straight from your board.

- Turn on your Halo Board.
- Turn on Bluetooth on your smart phone or music device and select scan.
- Look for the new Halo Board device to pair with once scanning has finished. Select pair from your device to connect with the Halo Board.
- You may now play music of your choice from your device.



## TIPS FOR SAFETY:

---

- Always make sure your Halo Board is on the ground in the ready-to-ride position before powering it “ON”.
- Never pick up your Halo Board while the power is turned “ON”.
- Always observe local traffic laws and regulations regarding riding on sidewalks and trails.
- Ride defensively. Always assume other have not seen you.
- Be ready to avoid or yield to vehicles, parked cars, pedestrians, pets or children, pot holes, and other hazardous road conditions.
- Always wear shoes that stay on your feet and that grip the board. Never ride barefoot or wear sandals-
- Wear protective clothing at all times, including a helmet, wrist guards, and elbow and knee pads
- Avoid street with water, sand, gravel, and other debris. Never ride in the rain.
- NEVER ride near motor vehicles.
- Never carry a passenger.
- Use approved hand signals for turning and stopping.
- Stop at stop signs and traffic lights and look both ways before crossing any intersection.
- Never ride your Halo Board while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Do not ride at night or during times of low visibility.

### PLEASE NOTE:

Avoid riding your Halo Board on inclines or declines steeper than 18%, and avoid jumping and stunt riding your Halo Board. This will void your warranty.



## WARRANTY

---

This agreement outlines the WARRANTY coverage supplied by Halo Board. The company warrants that the product will be free from defect in materials and workmanship for a period of 3 months. If the product is defective and a claim is filed during the warranty period, Halo Board, at its option, will replace your Halo Board.

The following situations are beyond the warranty scope.

- Total Mileage over 500 Km.
- Damage has been caused by misuse or modification.
- The product has been dismantled or repaired by an unauthorized third party.
- Damage or fault has been caused by other issues.
- Natural wear and tear that does not affect product function (scratches, wear & tear on frame, foot-pads).
- Damage has been caused by accidents, such as breakage caused by dropping or rusting in wet environment.
- Damage caused by overloading the Halo Board.
- Damage caused by acts-of-God, such as fire, flood, freezing, etc.
