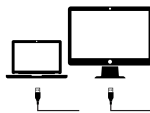




QUICK START

MAC- You can connect to your Mac using the USB cable or 3.5mm cable. To set up sound on a Mac via USB, begin by plugging the USB cable into the Mac. Next, go into "System Preferences" and select "Sound". Once "Sound" is selected, click on the "Output" tab and select "PuroGamer". You will then need to click on the "Input" tab and select "PuroGamer". Once completed you can begin using your gaming headphones. If you want to connect with the 3.5mm audio cable simply plug the headphones into the 3.5mm audio jack of your Mac. You will then need to complete the same steps as above. *Please note that when connected with the 3.5mm cable the device name will appear as "Headphones", and the Mic will appear as "External Microphone". You should only connect with the USB or 3.5mm audio cable. Do not connect with both.

PC- You can connect to your PC using the USB cable or 3.5mm cable. To set up sound on a Windows PC via USB, you will start by plugging the USB cable into your PC. Next, you will have to go to the "sound" setting on the PC and click on the "Playback" tab, then right-click on "PuroGamer" and select "Save as Default Device". To activate the Microphone, you will click on the "Recording" tab and right click on "PuroGamer" and then select "Save as Default Device". If you want to connect with the 3.5mm audio cable simply plug the headphones into the 3.5mm audio jack of your PC. You will then need to complete the same steps as above. *Please note that when connected with the 3.5mm cable the device name will appear as "Headphones", and the Mic will appear as "External Microphone". You should only connect with the USB or 3.5mm audio cable. Do not connect with both.



Cautions

1. Please only use the USB cable or 3.5mm cable when connecting to your device. If you connect with both your headphones will not function properly.
2. When you are connected via the USB please do not unplug the USB while in use. This can cause your computer to crash/reboot. Please eject the USB in your computer's settings or power the computer down before you unplug to avoid any issues.
3. When using the microphone be sure to switch toggle left or right on control box based on connection being used, (3.5 mm / USB) If switched wrong, it may alter the sound coming through.

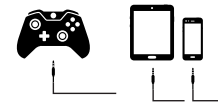


Split Plugs

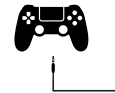
1. 3,5 mm aux cable PS4, Xbox, and mobile device gaming
2. USB cable for PC and Mac gaming

How to use

Xbox, and Mobile- Simply plug the 3.5 mm audio cable into your controller or mobile device. This will give the user game and chat audio while activating the mic for in game communication.

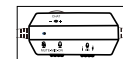


PlayStation- Either plug your headphones into the controller using the 3.5mm cable or directly into the PS4 via USB. Next, turn on your PlayStation and go to the settings menu. After you have the settings menu up, scroll down and select "Devices". Once you are there you will need to select "Audio Devices", scroll down and select the "Output to Headphones" tab. Once you are there you will need to select "All Audio". Note- you should only connect with the USB or 3.5mm cable. Do not connect with both.



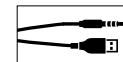
Caractéristiques

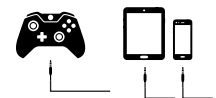


Bouchons fendus

1. Jeu de câble auxiliaire 3,5 mm PS4, Xbox et jeux sur appareils mobiles
2. Câble USB pour les jeux sur PC et Mac

Comment utiliser

Xbox et mobile: branchez simplement le câble audio 3,5 mm sur votre contrôleur ou votre appareil mobile. Cela donnera à l'utilisateur un son de jeu et de discussion tout en activant le micro pour la communication en jeu.



PlayStation- Connectez votre casque au contrôleur à l'aide du câble 3,5 mm ou directement à la PS4 via USB. Ensuite, allumez votre PlayStation et accédez au menu des paramètres. Une fois le menu des paramètres affiché, faites défiler vers le bas et sélectionnez «Périphériques». Une fois sur place, vous devrez sélectionner «Périphériques audio», faire défiler la liste et sélectionner l'onglet «Sortie vers le casque». Une fois que vous êtes là, vous devrez sélectionner "Tout l'audio". Remarque: vous ne devez vous connecter qu'avec le câble USB ou 3,5 mm. Ne vous connectez pas avec les deux.
