3. What plant grows closest to your front door?

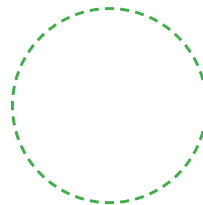
4. What non-cultivated wild edible plant grows closest to that same door?
