EN ISO 20471:2013+A1:2016 Protective Clothing – High visibility warning clothing

This high visibility garment must not be modified. It must be kept clean to be effective. Replace the garment if permanently stained or faded, or otherwise damaged. Regular comparison against a new garment is recommended. The aftercare instructions must be followed as improper treatment may alter the garment's performance. The index number refers to the area of visible material (1 to 3 - where 3 is highest class of conspicuity) Limitations of use: this garment should be worn fastened at all times to provide optimum conspicuity.

RIS 3279 TOM - Rail Industry Standard for High Visibility Clothing

This document mandates minimum requirements for high visibility clothing that is to be provided for wearing by people when on the lineside or on or near the line. It applies to all high visibility clothing worn in order to meet the requirements of GE/RT8000 Rule Book.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

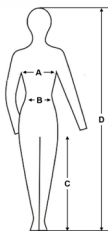
To obtain the best possible protection and comfort when using this safety product, it is essential that you read and observe the following information.

- Important!**
  - In order not to decrease the high visibility effect, please note the maximum washing temperature specified on the inside label.
  - Use a special detergent for coloured fabrics, without optical brighteners.
  - Do not use any macroemulsions. We recommend washing the protective garments separately and not with other garments.
  - We recommend washing the protective garments separately and not with other garments.
- Maximum Wash Cycles:**  
 The stated maximum number of cleaning cycles (5X) on the product is not the only factor related to the lifetime of the garment. The lifetime will also depend on usage, care, storage etc. This maximum number of wash cycles is limited to the products material/fabric makeup. The reflective hi-visibility bands on this product however have been tested to a 25x wash cycle.
- Instructions for cleaning:**  
 The bright colour Orange material within this garment over a period of time will change from its original shade to a lesser shade of orange. Discoloration will/can occur through the incorrect washing of the garment, the use of excess and harsh detergents, the environmental conditions the garments are/have been used in, prolonged UV light exposure, prolonged exposure to dirt and grime. Use of the product other than that intended.

After washing lay the garment flat and reshape whilst still wet.

- Storage and transport**  
 The garment should be stored in a dry well-ventilated room. Allow to dry thoroughly, avoid excessive folding, store preferably vertically away from UV light and exposure to liquids.
- Fitting and Sizing** – To put on and take off the garment always take care, fully open the zip. Only wear garments of a suitable size. Products which are either too loose or too tight will restrict movement and will not provide the optimum level of protection. The size of these garments is marked on a label attached inside.
