Main Plate
2 Posts
2 Phillips Large Screws
4 Phillips Small Screws

Tools needed for installation



From your garage toolbox (from left to right):

- 8 mm (or 5/16") open wrench **or** adjustable wrench
- Phillips screwdriver

From your Kawasaki Versys toolkit (on the right):

• 4 mm hex wrench

Installation Instructions

Assemble the GPS Mount.
 Lay down the Main Plate with the beveled edge of the plate down, and position the two posts as seen in the photo



2) Attach the posts to the main plate with the 4 small Phillips screws by putting the screws through the plate from the bottom side and screwing them into the posts



3) Remove 4 screws from the windscreen by using the 4 mm hex wrench and the 8 mm open wrench



4) Once the windscreen is removed, install the GPS Mount with the 2 large screws to the brackets of the windscreen.



You can use either one of the three upper holes depending on how you have your windscreen installed.

5) Tighten all the screws.



6) Reinstall the windscreen
