

Kawasaki Versys GPS Mount Installation Instructions

Thank you for purchasing our GPS Mount!

Items included



- Main Plate
- 2 Posts
- 2 Phillips Large Screws
- 4 Phillips Small Screws

Tools needed for installation



From your garage toolbox (from left to right):

- 8 mm (or 5/16") open wrench **or** adjustable wrench
- Phillips screwdriver

From your Kawasaki Versys toolkit (on the right):

- 4 mm hex wrench

Installation Instructions

- 1) Assemble the GPS Mount.
Lay down the Main Plate with the beveled edge of the plate down, and position the two posts as seen in the photo



- 2) Attach the posts to the main plate with the 4 small Phillips screws by putting the screws through the plate from the bottom side and screwing them into the posts



- 3) Remove 4 screws from the windscreen by using the 4 mm hex wrench and the 8 mm open wrench



- 4) Once the windscreen is removed, install the GPS Mount with the 2 large screws to the brackets of the windscreen.



You can use either one of the three upper holes depending on how you have your windscreen installed.

- 5) Tighten all the screws.



- 6) Reinstall the windscreen
