Bluebird Inlay Kit Instructions

Kit components

- 1: 1 x Maple Barrel with laser cutout
- 2: Color inlay pieces.

Step 1:

Remove all components from the plastic bag and place on a clean work surface. Please note that the components are small and you can loose them quite easily.

Step 2:

Take the barrel with the laser cutout and slide the brass tube(27/64) into it. Please do not use any glue at this stage, this is only to assist you with the assembly process.

Step 3:

Take the Barrel with cutout and place the inlays into the openings . Place part nr 1 into the corresponding opening first then follow with the rest of the numbers. There is no particular order to assemble this kit. Please note that some of the pieces are very small so make sure that they are secure before you place the next piece.

You can use a little bit of water and wet the inlay before you press it in. Use masking tape to tape the pieces into place.

Apply a small amount of thin CA glue so it would stick to the main barrel. You can use CA accelerator to speed up the curing of the CA glue.

Step 5

Remove the brass tube and put a small drop of thin CA on each inserted part.

Step 6

Now you can trim / cut / sand the barrel to size and glue the brass tube into the barrel with a glue of your choice and please give it enough time to dry before turning the barrel into shape. Try to sand the barrel round and smooth before you use a skew or any other tool to finish your pen.
