
## What is a "Drive for Show Putt for Dough" Office Challenge?

#### **Putt18 Office Golf Prizes:**

The two lowest scores play in the final against each other for the "Putt18 Office Golf - "BEST PUTTER" award.

- Best Putter Award Awarded to the winner of the final 2 playoff
- Runner Up Second place winner
- Best Team Lowest average score or team with the most birdies if there is a tie
- Most Birdies Individual Player with the most birdies
- Encouragement Award Greatest improvement yet to be seen, but it will be so great when it happens.

#### **Putt18 Office Golf Rules:**

Each player has 9 putts which represents putting to 9 holes. Your score depends on where the ball finishes. Balls coming to rest within the following areas are scored the following way:

```
Blue circle = a Par or 0

Red circle = a Birdie or -1

White circle = an Eagle or -2.

Anywhere on the Green area = a Bogey or +1

In a Bunker = a Double Bogey or +2

In a Water Hazard = a Triple Bogey or +3

Putt the ball off the mat = a Triple Bogey or + 3
```

### "Rogers" Roll Back Bar:

We have included a Roll Back Bar to make it easier for those unfamiliar with putting a golf ball. If a putt is hit slightly harder than required the ball should roll back onto the putting mat surface. If the ball comes to rest and it is determined by the Host that the ball is on the line, then the player or team has the option to take the higher value or replay the putt.
