

SCHOOL PUTTING EVENT

OUTLINE OF PUTTING COMPETITION: Single Player 9 Hole Stroke Format

3, 6 or 9 Mat Kit - Putting Format

- Event Duration is usually 30 to 40 minutes depending on the number of students
- Set up the mats so that the end of the mat facing a wall
- Ensure that the mats are evenly spaced leaving enough room for players to putt
- Place one putter and 3 soft golf balls on each putting
- Ensure that each student places their name of the student individual summary sheet
- Explain the scoring to the group
- Separate the students into teams of even numbers. A maximum of 4 players per mat is ideal.
- Hand out the team scorecards
- Have the students create a team name
- Have the students write their names on the cards
- Scoring:
 - Student on the Putting Mat putts 3 balls whilst the student behind them writes down their score on the scorecard
 - The balls are then picked up and placed in front of the next person
 - The student then retreats to the end of the team awaiting their next 3 putts
 - The student behind the person on the Putting Mats hand the scorecard to the person behind them and so on.
- The lowest 2 players plus ties play in a 9 or 18-hole final
 - There are several variations:
 - Example: Lowest 2 and Highest 2 play a final 9 or 18-hole final
- The best team is awarded to the lowest average score. Calculated by the total team score divided by the number of players.
 - There are several variations:
 - Example: Best two teams play a final 9 or 18-hole final
