Risk assessment focus: To ensure the safety of children and staff when playing Putt N Play. Putt N Play is the activity mentioned within the Risk Management Plan 2023.

Location / Activity	Hazard Identification Type / Cause	Risk matrix score	Elimination or Control Measures	Who	When
Inside or Outside a Daycare Centre or School/ Putt N Play	Physical injury/ trip hazard. People or staff may trip on a Mini Set. Not looking where you are going. Mini sets are placed in thoroughfares.	Possible/ Minor/ Medium	Ensure that the Mini Sets are visible and placed in areas where other students and staff can pass by them without having to step over them. Visually check that the activity zone is free from trip hazards.	School/Childcare staff	Before commencing and during the activity.
Inside or Outside a Daycare Centre or School/ Putt N Play	Physical injury/ A person may swing the Golf Putter and hit someone or something.	Possible/ Minor/ Medium	Addressing the students before commencing the activity to not swing the putter like a golf club. To demonstrate the correct technique with putting a golf ball by putting a ball through one of the Mini Sets. To ensure children are always supervised during the activity. To ensure a one student per teacher or childcare worker ratio exists within the activity zone. Ensure there is at least 2 metre gap between children putting and the next child playing within the activity zone.	School/Childcare staff	Before commencing and during the activity.
Inside or Outside a Daycare Centre or School/ Putt N Play	Physical injury/ trip hazard. Child or staff may trip over a Golf Putter or Golf Ball laying on the ground in the surrounding area.	Possible/ Minor/Medium	Ensure that the Putters are always if the hands of a student, teacher or a childcare worker about a child completes the activity. Visually check that the activity zone is free from trip hazards before and during the activity.	School/Childcare staff	Before commencing and during the activity.
Inside or Outside a Daycare Centre or School/ Putt N Play	Physical injury/ A child may throw a rubber golf ball or putter at someone or something.	Unlikely/ Minor/Low	Addressing people before the activity commences instructing them not to throw the golf balls or putters. Ensuring that all elements of the Mini Set Kit have been returned the box and placed somewhere out of reach from children.	School/Childcare staff	Before commencing and during the activity.

Inside or Outside a Daycare Centre or School/ Putt N Play	Physical injury/ Incorrectly removing and inserting the equipment from the box	Unlikely/ Minor/Low	Ensure that the box is placed on a level and flat surface when removing the equipment from the box.	School/Childcare staff	Before commencing and during the activity.
Inside or Outside a Daycare Centre or School/ Putt N Play	Physical injury/ A person may collide into another person whilst playing the activity.	Unlikely/ Minor/Low	Ensure the activity is supervised by an adult when students are playing the game. Ensure a safe 2-meter distance between students within the activity zone.	School/Childcare staff	Before commencing and during the activity.
Inside or Outside a Daycare Centre or School/ Putt N Play	Physical injury/ People may be exposed to the sun t if playing the activity in sunlight.	Unlikely/ Minor/Low	Ensure that students have the appropriate sun protection if playing the activity outside with access to sunlight. Reapply sunscreen according to regulations.	School/Childcare staff	Before commencing and during the activity.
Inside or Outside a Daycare Centre or School/ Putt N Play	Physical injury/ Centre staff may injury themselves if they drop the Putt N Play Box on their toes.	Unlikely/ Minor/ Low	Ensure that when carrying the Putt N Play kit that there are appropriate staff available should the staff feel the kit is too heavy for one person. Ensure the Putt N Play Kit is stored where it cannot fall over or injury anyone.	School/Childcare staff	Before commencing and during the activity.
