SHOTGUN SOLO-VAULT



• FEATURES

- Accommodates left and right handed shotguns.
- Secures most pump, semi-auto, double barrel, side by side and over/under shotguns.
- Will fit some pistol grip (pump) shotguns.
- Flanged, no pry lid with dual internal locking hooks.

MOUNTING YOUR SHOTGUN SOLO-VAULT




Don't forget, adhere logo sticker to front.

- Securely attach vault in convenient location with the provided Vault Mounting Screws. *
- Pump Ejection Port Hanger may also be mounted on opposite side to reverse the direction the door opens.


^{*} PLEASE NOTE: In order to be compliant with California DOJ standards, the Shotgun Solo-Vault must be mounted to a surface using the Mounting Screws, and the firearm must be secured using the Ejection Port Hanger or Trigger Blocks. The exposed screws on the back should not be accessible once the device is mounted and locked.

ASSEMBLY FOR SEMI-AUTO AND OVER/UNDER SHOTGUNS


- 1. Lay vault down either left or right opening, as preferred.
- 2. Lay shotgun down inside vault with bolt, handle pointing up and position Trigger Guard Blocks snugly around trigger assembly.
- When action is closed, bolt handle should extend outside the vault through the door opening, and as close as possible to the top of the door.
- 4. When action is open, handle will protrude through the hole in the door.
- 5. Trace the positions of the Trigger Guard Blocks onto the Foam, then cut Foam Bed Liners to fit around Trigger Guard Blocks.
- 6. Using M5x14mm screws attach Trigger Guard Blocks to securely confine trigger assembly inside vault.
- 7. Insert Foam Bed Liner.
- * The second piece of foam is a backup.



ASSEMBLY FOR PUMP SHOTGUNS



- For right-handed shotguns, Pump Ejection Port Hanger will be mounted top right. For left-handed shotguns, Pump Ejection Port Hanger will be mounted top left.
- Trace the position of the Pump Ejection Port Hanger onto the Foam Bed Liner, then cut Foam Bed Liner to fit around Hanger.
- 4. Using M5x14mm screws attach Pump Ejection Port Hanger to inside of yault.
- 5. Insert Foam Bed Liner.
- 6. With action open, place ejection port over Pump Ejection Port Hanger.
 - * The second piece of foam is a backup.



MOUNTING YOUR HANDGUN SOLO-VAULT

- Securely attach Handgun Solo-Vault in convenient location using 4 mounting screws.
- You may also secure your Handgun Solo-Vault by threading a heavy 5/16" locking cable through the provided port holes.
- Be sure to adhere the ShotLock logo to the front side of your Handgun Solo-Vault.



QUICKDRAWER SOLO-VAULT™ 200M PARTS



MOUNTING YOUR QUICKDRAWER SOLO-VAULT 200M



1. Remove cover plate from body.



 Open the unit. Flip upside-down, and then press the tabs located on the bottom of the glides. Once released, pull the drawer out and set aside.



3. Hold the mounting plate in desired location, making sure hooks are facing outwards, and mark holes for drilling with a pencil. Set plate aside and drill pilot holes with a 1/8" drill bit.



4. Attach the mounting plate (using a screwdriver or power drill) to desired surface using provided surface mounting screws.

5. Slide body into mounting plate hooks, making sure hooks are inserted all the way. At this point the body is not secured to the mounting plate. Be careful the body does not come free of the mounting plate.



 Attach body to mounting plate using provided mounting plate screws and Allen wrench.



 Reinsert drawer into body by carefully lining up glides, and pushing drawer in until you hear a distinct click.



 Test the drawer unit by unlocking and pressing to activate the spring-loaded release.



MOUNTING YOUR AR SOLO-VAULT:

- · Determine desired mounting location.
- · Locate stud in wall.
- Secure AR SOLO-VAULT to Stud using 3 mounting screws (provided)
- Adjust Pistol Grip Hangar as necessary by loosening the 2 (7 mm) attaching nuts and sliding the hangar to the desired position. When desired position is achieved, re-tighten the 2 (7 mm) nuts.
- Set combination on lock (following instructions in owners manual).



Ensure all 3 mounting screws are in a stud to achieve maximum security

OPERATING THE M-SERIES MECHANICAL LOCK

TO OPEN WITH FACTORY CODE: Factory combination is 1 - 2 - 7 - 8. Before setting the new combination, we recommend recording your new password in the provided space on page 10.

• Changing your combination can usually be done in less than five minutes.

Please reference pages 12-13 to change your electric lock combination.

UNLOCK



Enter in your four digit combination code, (each punch should provide a distinct "click").



Turn the locking knob to the "Open" position and then proceed to open the door.

LOCK



Ensure the locking knob is in the "Open" position and then close the door.



While holding the door closed, turn the locking knob to the "Lock" position.

KEY OVERRIDE



Insert your key into the lock and turn to unlock position.
Then turn the locking knob into the "Open" position.




When finished, close the door, and turn locking knob to "Lock" position. Return key into lock position, and then remove the key.

© CHANGING COMBINATION (M-SERIES LOCK)

Introduction: Changing your combination can usually be done in less than five minutes. Of the 8 numbers possible, 4 numbers will need to be used for your custom combination. Factory combination is 1 - 2 - 7 - 8. Also, before setting the new combination, we recommend you record the new four digit code on page 10 of this manual.







*See page 25 for AR lock module access. *GETTING STARTED*

- Remove both Phillips screws (one on each side of the box) and slide the metal cover vertically.
- Pull the lock module out as shown (no hardware disassembly required).
- Once the combination pin box is removed, use your thumb to push the center gray slide and either the left or right unlock button to release the spring pressure, on all 8 pins (buttons facing up).
- While holding these two buttons, pull out the A, B, C, and D pins (stamped on side of the pins).
 - These four pins are your combination pins.
 Place the four pins on a table and release the thumb pressure on the two buttons.
 - All remaining pins are blanks, and will always be located in the slots not associated with the combination. All blank pins are identical and can be inserted into any (non-combination) locations.

SETTING NEW COMBINATION

- 5. Any new combination you pick will always need to be sequential when you enter your combination to unlock your ShotLock. For example: when entering the numbers out of your chosen sequence, it will not open.
- To obtain the correct sequence with your new combination, we suggest to record your code in the designated box on page 10.

- 7. To insert the pins back into the module, press the two slides at the same time (see step 3). Proceed to insert the four pins into the correct locations.
 - Any blank that may be still in one of these slots, can be removed and placed into any other location.
 - Each time you insert a pin, gently push the pin all the way in to insure it is seated into its location.
- 8. Once finished, and all eight pins are installed, release your thumb, and gently press all eight pins to insure each snap in and out smoothly. If a pin does not, simply repeat steps 3 and 7 for that individual pin.
- 9. Once your new combination is complete, simply set the module back into its location. If the module seats into its three location pins, it will snap in place, and stay put in its cradle. If the module won't stay in place, put back into the cradle until you feel it snap into place.
- 10. Slide the metal cover back into place. Place special attention and have the cover follow the vertical guide rails. (See page 25 for AR access).
 - If the cover won't go on easily, that usually means your lock module is not snapped into proper place.
- 11. Insert the two Phillips screws back into place, and now you are done!
- 12. Once installed, we recommend trying your new combination with the ShotLock door still open, in case you have placed a pin incorrectly by accident and the combination does not work as planned. If this happens, just remove again, and follow the previous instructions.









OPERATING THE E-SERIES ELECTRICAL LOCK

TO OPEN FOR THE FIRST TIME: Batteries are included but not installed. You will need to access the ShotLock using the Key Override to install the batteries initially.

TO OPEN WITH FACTORY CODE: Factory combination is 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 plus "OK". You will hear a single short beep if the combination was successful. A short double beep indicates a wrong combination was entered. To change the combination please see page 16.

TO CHANGE THE BATTERIES: A short triple beep indicates low battery power. To change the batteries, first open the ShotLock to access the interior battery cover plate. Use the provided Allen Wrench to remove the battery cover plate, and replace the 4 AA batteries. Reattach the battery cover plate.

TO DISABLE THE BEEP: If you wish to turn off the beeps emitted by pressing a button, simply press and hold "1" for 5 seconds. To re-enable the beeps, press and hold "2" for 5 seconds.

UNLOCK



Punch in your multidigit code, then press OK. You will hear a single short beep if the code was successful.



Turn the locking knob to the "Open" position and proceed to open the door.

LOCK



Ensure the locking knob is in the "Open" position and then close the door.



While holding the door closed, turn the locking knob to the "Lock" position.

KEY OVERRIDE



Insert your key into the lock and turn to unlock position. Then turn the locking knob into the "Open" position.



When finished, close the door, and turn locking knob to "Lock" position.
Return key into lock position, and then remove the key.

CHANGING COMBINATION (E-SERIES LOCK)

Introduction: Changing your combination is easy and takes less than a minute. The E-series lock offers over 1 million combination possibilities. Your code can be anywhere from 4 digits up to 10 digits in length. Also, before setting the new combination, we recommend you record the new combination code on page 14 of this manual.







GETTING STARTED


- Open your ShotLock with your current electronic combination, OR by using the Key Override.
- Make sure the locking knob is in the "OPEN" position.
- Enter your new combination (4 to 10 digits) and press and HOLD the OK Key until a short beep is heard.
- Quickly enter your new combination again, and press and HOLD the OK Key again until a LONG beep is heard.
- 5. The long beep CONFIRMS your new combination. DOUBLE beep means an ERROR, and start over at Number 4 (above).
 - Any new combination you pick will always need to be sequential when you enter your combination to unlock your ShotLock. For example: when entering the numbers out of your chosen sequence, it will not open.
 - To obtain the correct sequence with your new combination, we suggest you record your code in the designated box on page 14.

■ EMERGENCY BATTERY BACKUP INSTRUCTIONS (E-SERIES LOCK)

If all three of the provided keys have been misplaced, and the internal battery has expired, ShotLock provides another opportunity for you to get your ShotLock open.

OPERATING THE EMERGENCY BATTERY BACKUP

- Each E-Series lock comes with an Emergency Battery Backup Kit.
 Four AA batteries are required, but not included.
- 2. Install batteries into your included Emergency Battery Backup Kit.
- 3. Plug the pin into the DC hole on the top of the faceplate.
 - This will energize the internal electronics allowing you to enter your combination to access the ShotLock.
- 4. While keeping the pin in the DC hole, push your combination and the "OK key. This will activate the unlock feature. Proceed to open your Shot-Lock Solo-Vault.
- 5. Finally, be sure to open the battery plate and replace the expired batteries (four AA) for future use.
 - We recommend changing batteries annually.







AR SOLO-VAULT LOCK MODULE ACCESS (M-SERIES LOCK)



1. Remove Phillips screw from lock module cover.



2. Remove lock module cover.



- Pull the lock module out as shown (no hardware disassembly required).
- 4. Follow steps on pages 19-20 to reset lock combination.



5. Insert lock module back into lock, replace lock module cover and lock module cover screw.
