



THE INFORMATION ENCLOSED PROVIDES A QUICK REFERENCE OF THE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF YOUR QUICKTOUCH VAULT. READ THE FOLLOWING SAFETY PRECAUTIONS BEFORE USE. WE ADVISE YOU RETAIN THIS MANUAL FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.

 Extreme temperatures may affect the power supply of this product. Exposing to extreme heat or cold may affect the battery power.

DO NOT PLACE OR STORE THE BACKUP KEYS INSIDE THE VAULT AT ANY TIME. STORE THEM IN AN ALTERNATIVE LOCATION, AS BACKUP.

- Remove ammunition from gun before storing in this product. Firearms are serious in nature and
 must be handled with respect. Store responsibly. Be sure to follow all local and state firearm laws.
 Do not operate a firearm without proper training and experience.
- Always check to ensure the door has latched when closing. The vault lid may require a firm press to lock. Do not over-stuff your product. This may cause the locking mechanism to jam. If this occurs, use the backup key to unlock.



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




CONNECTING TO POWER

The vault requires a power source to operate the locking mechanism - AC power or batteries.

 When powered by the AC power cable, the vault is constantly at the ready. Plug in a power cable (not included) into the power cable port at the side corner of the vault. The constant power source means the device will bypass using the batteries for use.




- When AC power cable is not available, the vault can be powered by four AAA batteries.
 - 1. First, use a backup key to open the vault door.
 - Locate the battery compartment and remove the battery pack.
 - Insert four AAA alkaline batteries (not included) into the battery pack, replace back into the battery compartment, and close. When closed, you will hear a short beep. This confirms correct installation of the batteries.
 - 4. Close the cover and secure the screw, or leave the cover off if programming next.




NOTE: IF ALL KEYS LIGHT UP BLUE 10 TIMES WITH 10 BEEPS WHEN OPENING THE SAFE BY USING THE KEYPAD, YOUR BATTERY LEVEL IS CRITICALLY LOW AND YOUR SAFE NEEDS TO BE REPLACED WITH NEW BATTERIES.

Should the vault keypad completely loose power, you can still gain access to the vault by using the backup keys to manually open through the keyhole on the top of the vault.

IMPORTANT: ONLY USE A 6V ADAPTER, HIGHER VOLTAGE WILL DAMAGE THE DIGITAL COMPONENTS.





CODE PROGRAMMING

After unpackaging your vault, users should change the default code as soon as possible to prevent unauthorized access to your vault.

NOTE: THE KEYPAD WILL TIME OUT AND SLEEP FOR FIVE MINUTES IF FIVE INCORRECT ENTRIES ARE MADE. THE VAULT CAN STILL BE OPENED BY USING THE BACKUP KEYS OVERRIDE.

- 1. Enter default code 1-2-3-4 on the keypad to open the vault.
- With the vault open, press and hold the PROGRAM button for three seconds. All keypad keys (1-4) will light up once with one beep.
- Enter the NEW code.
 - The code can be a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 8 digits.
 - Two keys cannot be pressed simultaneously.


IMPORTANT: ENTERING A NEW CODE WILL OVERRIDE THE PREVIOUS CODE.

- After entering the new code, press the PROGRAM button once and release it. All keypad keys (1-4) will light up twice with the double beeps, which confirms that the new code has been set successfully.
- Now test the code: close the door and enter the code. If you make a mistake and the new code will not work, use the backup keys to open the vault and program the code again.

NOTE: TO SILENCE THE AUDIBLE SOUND OF THE ELECTRONICS, HOLD THE "1" BUTTON FOR 4 SECONDS UNTIL YOU HEAR ONE BEEP AND ALL KEYS WILL FLASH TOGETHER. TO UNMUTE THE KEYS. REPEAT THIS STEP.

ANCHORING THE VAULT

As the vault size is quite portable, it is strongly recommended that you anchor your vault securely to a floor or wall. Placing a protective barrier (such as a piece of carpet, rubber matting, or wood) between the vault and the floor is beneficial to avoid scratching (leading to rust). Use the mounting screws included to mount your vault to a flat surface using the pre-drilled holes at the bottom.



IMPORTANT: MOUNT THE UNIT IN A VERTICAL ORIENTATION SO THAT THE VAULT DOOR FACES DOWNWARD OR TO THE SIDE. IF MOUNTED WITH THE VAULT DOOR FACING UPWARD, THIS WILL RESULT IN FAILURE TO UNLOCK AND OPEN THE VAULT DUE TO WEIGHT COMPENSATION.

- Measure and position the vault on a flat surface where you want to mount it. Ensure there is enough space to open the vault door. Use a pencil to mark the holes for drilling.
- 2. Drill pilot holes.
- 3. Position vault in place and install screws through the inside of the vault, into pilot holes. Tighten screws completely.
- 4. Test the vault to ensure there is no issue.

USE & MAINTENANCE

Follow these tips to keep your vault in good condition for use and extend its lifetime:

- Do not over-stuff the vault, as this can cause damage to the locking mechanism. Ensure there is no
 pressure on the vault door when it is closed.
- Remove ammunition from guns before storing in the vault. Ensure they rest securely in their proper cutouts to prevent tipping when the door is closed.
- Use of this product in a very humid environment could interfere with the function of the keypad and locking mechanism. Moisture reducing products, such as a dehumidifier, would be useful to protect your vault, as well as your vault contents, from rust.
- It is recommended to check the batteries in your vault at least once a year. Replace as needed.
- To clean the exterior of your vault, use a soft, non-abrasive cloth dampened with water. Do not use
 a soaking wet cloth, as this could cause damage to the locking mechanism.
- This vault is not waterproof. If the product is exposed to fire or water, the fire insulation of your vault will be compromised. Should your vault experience either of these conditions, have your vault opened and emptied as soon as possible. If your vault contents includes firearms, remove and have them cleaned and lubricated as soon as possible. Do not continue to store items in a vault that has been compromised by water or fire.

WARRANTY

SureLock Security Company® ("SureLock", "SureLock Security", or "SureLock Security Co.") cabinets, vaults and safes, manufactured by Dansons, carry a limited warranty from the date of sale by the original owner. The warranty coverage begins on the original date of purchase and proof of date of purchase, or copy of original bill of sale, is required to validate the warranty.
