

Assemble Microbulator:

Compost teas are brewed through the use of a microbulator.

Step 1: Screw the male adaptor of tube into the microbulator base.

Step 2: Slide the riser pipe onto the base.

Step 3: Attach the return to the top.

Step 4: Face the return to the opposite direction of air input.

Step 5: Plug hose into the pump and place above the water level.

Step 6: Drop the assembled unit into a 5-gallon bucket filled with water.

Step 7: Attach small bungee cord over the unit to keep it from floating and keep the pump above the level of the water.



Brew the Compost Tea:

Once the microbulator is assembled, you can brew your tea.

Step 1: Drop the mesh bag into the bucket.

Step 2: Sprinkle the contents of the loose bag into the top of the bucket.

Step 3: Run your microbulator for 18 – 36 hours.

Step 4: Apply your compost tea within 4 hours of taking it off aeration.

KIS Organics recommends 5 applications (approximately 1 pint per plant each application) as a soil drench throughout the growing season.
