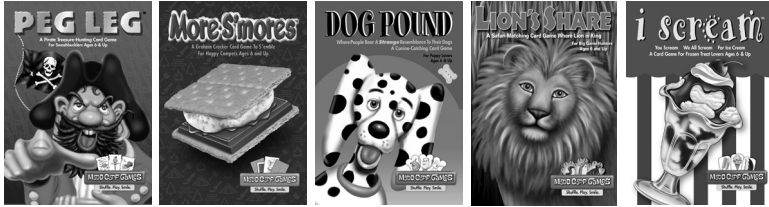

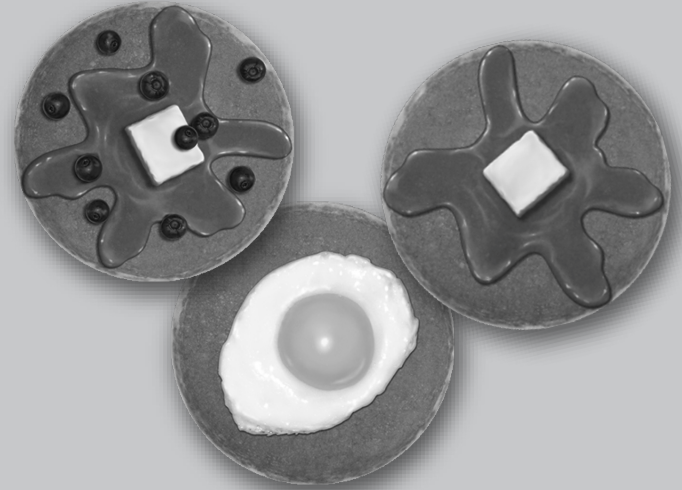

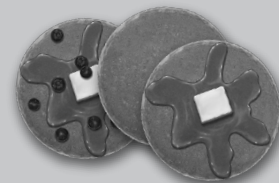

Object of the Game

The object of the game is to slap the most pancake-stacked Diner Plates. The player with the most points, wins.

How to Play

Shuffle and deal out the entire deck to each player, face down. Players do not look at their cards and keep them in a pile face down in front of them. Uneven counts are okay, as cards change hands quickly.

Next, shuffle the Diner Plates and place them face down on the table.

Each round begins by flipping over a Diner Plate in the middle of the table. Next, the youngest player flips the top card from their deck and places it face up on the Diner Plate.

Going clockwise, the next player flips over their top card and places it face up, directly on top of the Diner Plate stack.

Play continues clockwise until:

1. ONE OF THE "FANCY" PANCAKE CARDS IS TURNED UP:
When a player flips up a Pancake Card with either Butter,

Butter & Syrup, Butter, Syrup & Blueberries, or a Happy Face Fruit Medley Pancake Card, all players RACE to be the first to slap the stack. The first to slap wins the plate of pancakes and slides it over near them.

2. A SUNNY-SIDE-UP EGG CARD IS TURNED OVER:

When this card is turned over, try to be the first to slap it because it is worth more points than any other card in the deck!

Play continues:

Once a player wins a stack, turn over a new Diner Plate and start stacking those Pancake Cards all over again. The more stacks you slap, the more points you get, the more likely you are to win the game!

Who Wins?

When all eight Diner Plates of pancakes are won, the game is over. Any cards remaining are out of play. Players count up their points. The player with the highest score, wins.

Scoring

Count the points in each of your pancake stacks (be sure to double your points for every stack that sits on a Special Message Diner Plate), then tally the points for your total score.

Point Values for Each Card:

Plain Pancake = 1 point

Pancake with Butter = 2 points

Pancake with Butter & Syrup = 3 points

Pancake with Butter, Syrup & Blueberries = 4 points

Pancake with Happy Face Fruit Medley = 5 points

Pancake with Sunny-Side-Up Egg = 8 points
