

Installations:Doirin Ailinn, Killarney

From RVR



Doirin Alainn in Killarney is a 58 house development by Kerry County Council. In each of the houses there are Victrix 24X condensing gas boilers with hot water priority connected to a rapid recovery twin coil cylinder.

The heating system features weather compensation, where it can modulate down on warmer days to take account of outside air temperature. This comes complete with an automatic ramp up to high temperature for quick recovery of the hot water cylinder when required. These features are all built into the boiler control panel so this can be controlled centrally.

The heating system is zoned into 2no zones and controlled with Honeywell Chronostats with optimum start to further increase efficiency.

The lower coil in the cylinder is fed by the 2no Tisun solar panels flashed neatly into the roof of each house which supplies about 70% of the hot water needs of the residents for the year.

The contractor on this development was Niall O Connor Heating and Plumbing.
