



How to Cut with Attachment Comb

We recommended using the 12mm comb when trimming for the first time, cutting just a little hair with each stroke. Once you become familiar with using the device, you can use other comb sizes.



Hold the clipper up to steadily trim the hair from the front.





When cutting the hair on the back of the head, install 3/6/9mm comb. Slightly tilt the head face down and start from the middle in upward strokes.





When cutting the hair near ears, install 3/6/9mm comb to cut hair




