



THE DAVINCI GUIDE TO CHOOSING YOUR CRIB

1. CONVERTIBILITY

This allows for longevity as your baby grows. Conversion kits may be sold separately:



ADJUSTABLE MATTRESS HEIGHT: Most cribs offer between 2 and 4 levels, DaVinci standard cribs have 4 heights. As your child is able to pull him or herself to a standing position, you need to lower the mattress to reduce risk of climbing out.

2. SIZE & PORTABILITY

Consider a full-size, mini, or combo crib to best fit your available space and lifestyle



PORTABLE

Removable wheels or casters with locking mechanisms provide room-to-room mobility and stability



MINI

Perfect for smaller nurseries. Some mini cribs offer additional features of full-size cribs, such as conversion to twin bed



CRIB AND CHANGER COMBO

Typically incorporates a baby changing table or dresser to give you two essential nursery pieces in one. Conversion kits may be sold separately

3. SAFETY STANDARDS

Check the certifications on your crib:

GREENGUARD Gold: certification for healthy indoor air quality

CPSC: Consumer Products Safety Commission

ASTM: American Society for Testing and Materials

4. MATERIALS MATTER

A majority of cribs on the market are made of soft woods, hardwoods, or engineered woods. DaVinci uses sustainable New Zealand Pine. As always, ensure crib materials are sturdy and meets safety standards.
