**Sing with the Spirit!** is a lively partner song that ingeniously incorporates the melodies of several different traditional spirituals, including *Rise and Shine!*, *Every Time I Feel the Spirit, I'm Gonna Sing when the Spirit Says Sing, I'm Gonna Live So God Can Use Me* and *I'm Gonna Sing, Sing, Sing*. Appropriate for both school and church choirs, it may be performed by 2-part treble or mixed voices with a few voices singing the descant, or by treble or mixed voices divided into three equal parts.

Each of these spirituals in its original form includes references to the empowering experience of singing! In rehearsal, strive for a very light, articulate legato and a general feeling of two pulses per measure. Carefully observe the dynamic indications to highlight the entrances of the different melodies.

For performance by church choirs, suggested corresponding scripture readings include Psalm 47, 1 Corinthians 14: 6-15, Ephesians 5: 17-21 and Colossians 3: 12-17. One basic homiletical theme is singing and shouting God's praise, empowered by the Holy Spirit. This partner song may be performed throughout the year and especially on the Day of Pentecost.
