



## **Private Consultations**

**Northcote Pottery Supplies offer private consultations for persons that would like one-on-one tuition, in the areas of wheel throwing, hand building, mould making and slip casting.**

**Consultations are designed to offer participants the ability to learn specific techniques from experienced tutors that are not offered in our standard courses.**

**Consultations are not designed for those wanting to complete set work or projects, rather, to develop new skills so they can move forward confidently to introduce new techniques into their practice.**

## **Terms & Conditions**

Private consultations are \$90 per hour. Materials are additional and vary in price dependant on the consultation. A minimum booking of two hours is required for a private consultation or class.

To secure your private consultation we require full payment at the time of booking. Payment can be made in store, over the phone, or by direct deposit.

Cancellations will forfeit the full fee. However, you may find a replacement to take your place.

We are unable to transfer bookings or offer make-up classes under any circumstances.

Private consultations do not include glazing and firing.

Private consultations occur during business hours at Northcote Pottery Supplies, 142-144 Weston Street, Brunswick East, unless other arrangements are made. We do conduct tailored off-site consultations and activities, however additional fees may apply. Please ask for more information.

Please note: There are many steps involved in the ceramic process - making, drying (which can take up to a week or more depending on the size and thickness of the work), the first firing (bisque firing), decoration, glaze application, the second firing (glaze firing). These cannot be completed in one session.

Please discuss your requirements with staff before booking.

For current students at Northcote Pottery Supplies – work made during private consultations is to be kept separate from class work. It is to be stored on the Studio Access shelves, labelled with your name and date. Work is cleared from these shelves every two weeks.
