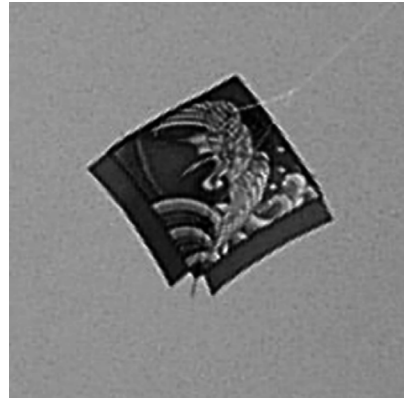


Traditional Japanese Kite GONBO



Materials

- Sail (Japanese paper) 1pc
- Horizontal spar 1pc
- Vertical spar 1pc
- Bamboo 1pc
- Paper tape 3pcs
- String 90cm (bow line) 1pc
- String 180cm 1pc
- Fin(orange paper) 2pcs
- Toothpick, Tag 1 each

How to make IKA

1

Decorate the paper front with whatever design you like. The paper front is slightly smooth and the top has the slits.

2

Attach the vertical spar to the paper with glue as illustrated. (Attach the bark side of the bamboo)

3

Pass the horizontal spar through the holes and attach it with glue. (Do not attach the bark side of the bamboo)

4

Form a bow of the bamboo and fold the black part inward. Put the bamboo and glue it.

5

Stick the paper tapes. Dip the paper tape to water when fixing.

6

Fold the black parts inward and glue them.

7

Tie the bow line to the ends of the horizontal spar. (Do not form a bow yet)

8

Attach the fins(orange paper).

9

Attach the bridle(180cm string). Follow the following procedure.

①Punch holes with a toothpick

11

Tag wire

② Turn the kite face up. Take off wire from the tag and use the wire. (substitute for needle)
Put string through each hole and around spar.

How to tie

③ Secure with knot, leaving about 5cm.

13

Find a hole 2.5cm below from the horizontal spar. Put the string together at this pivot point.

14

Make a loop at around tip of the string put together and tie end of flying line to this bridle loop.

15

Form the bow. The bow should be 7-8cm at its maximum point.
