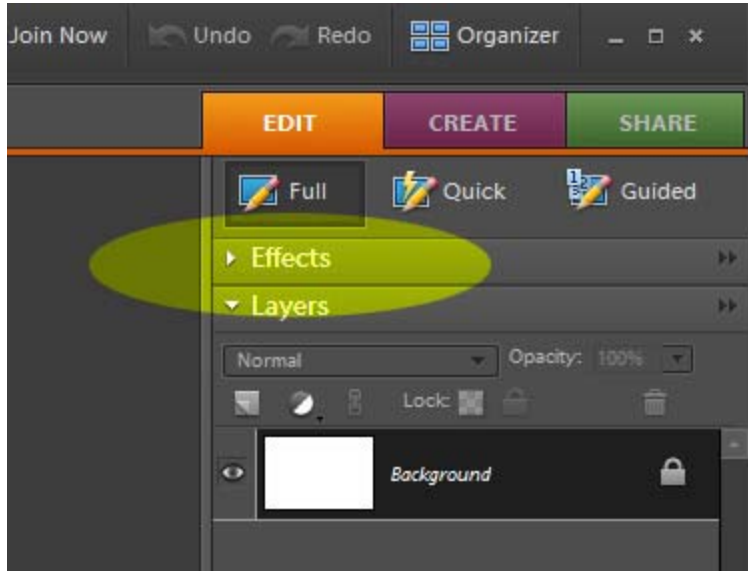

Loading Actions

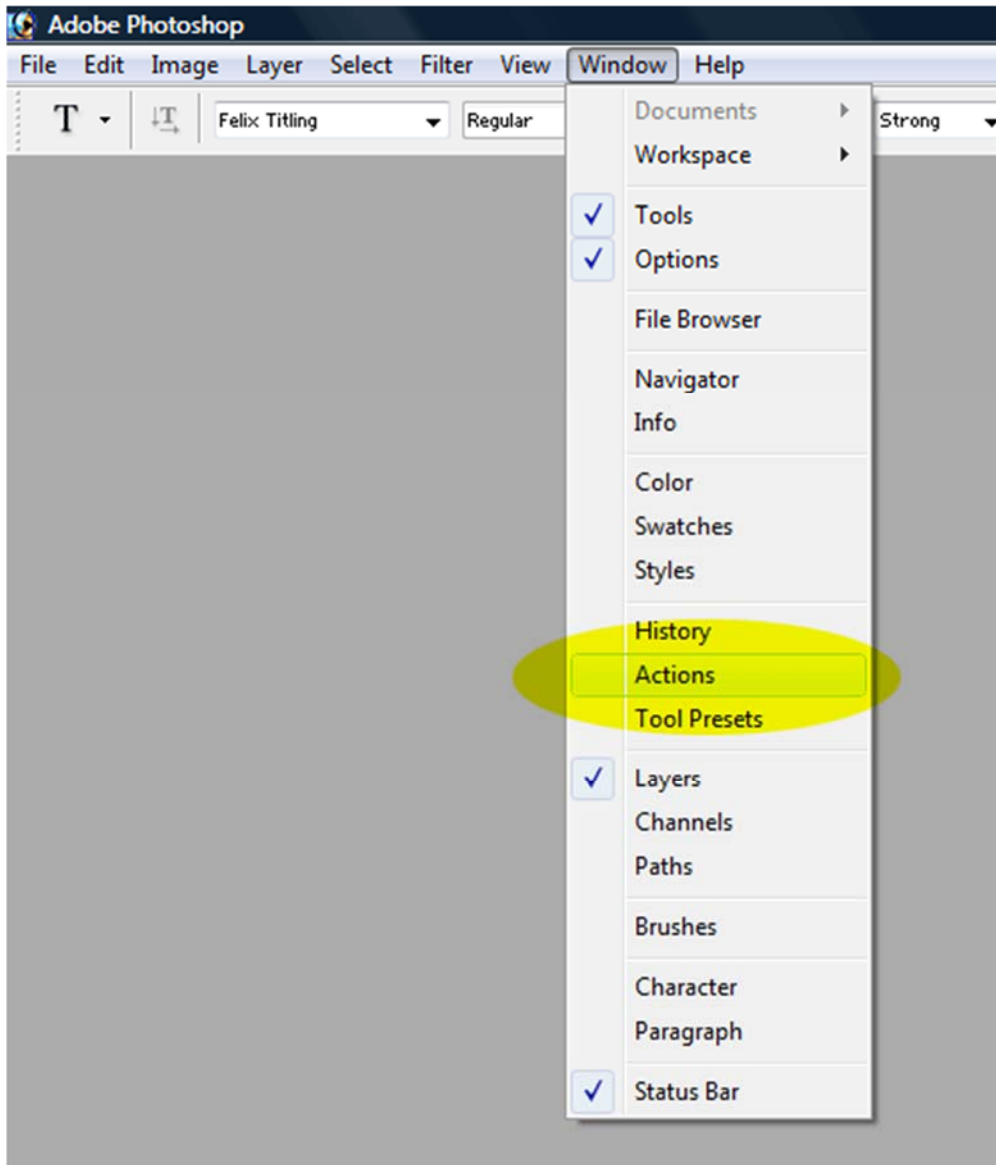


Once loaded, you can access your actions in Photoshop Elements by clicking on the Effects as seen in this example.

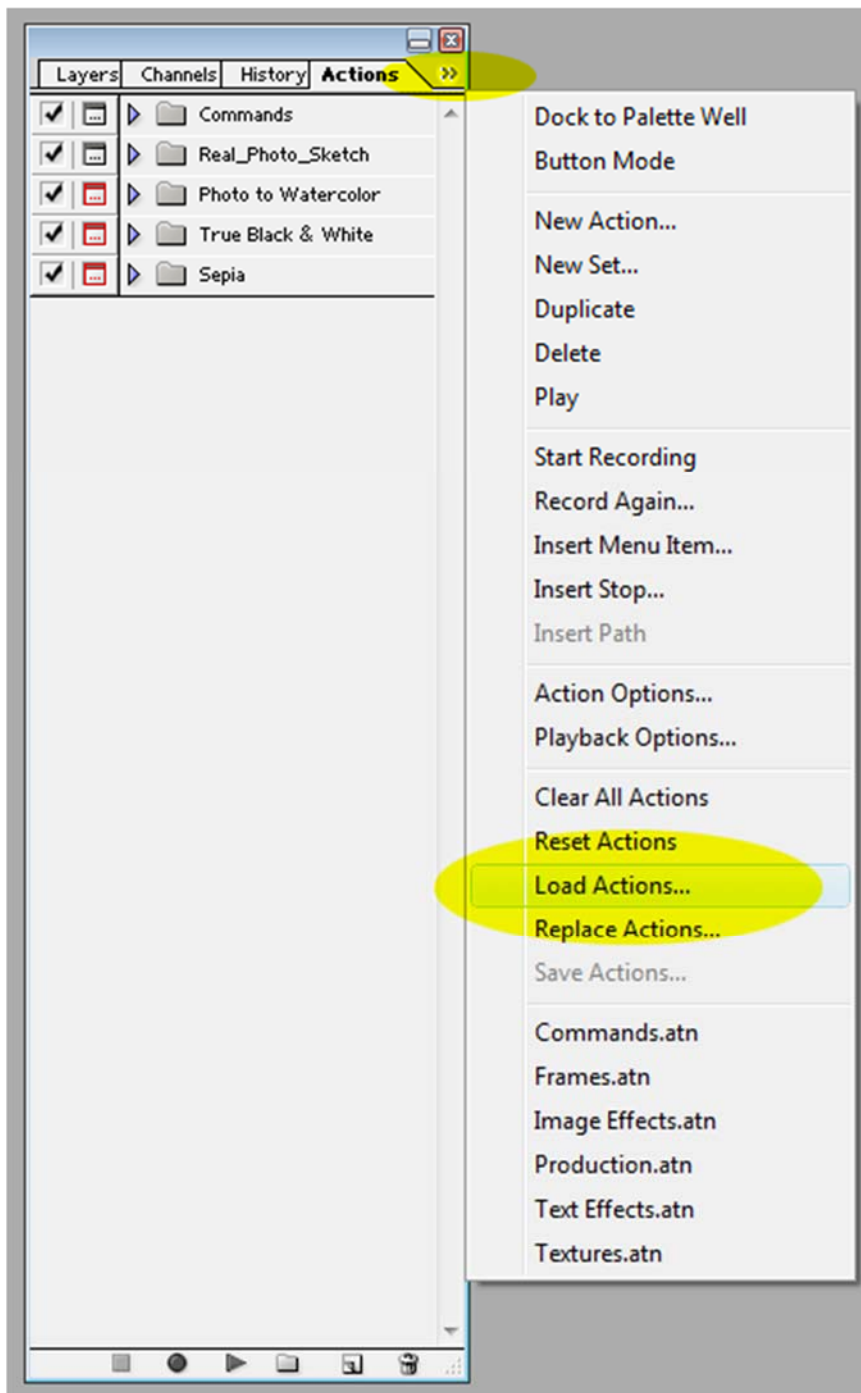

**\*\*\*LOADING ACTIONS - PHOTOSHOP USERS\*\*\***

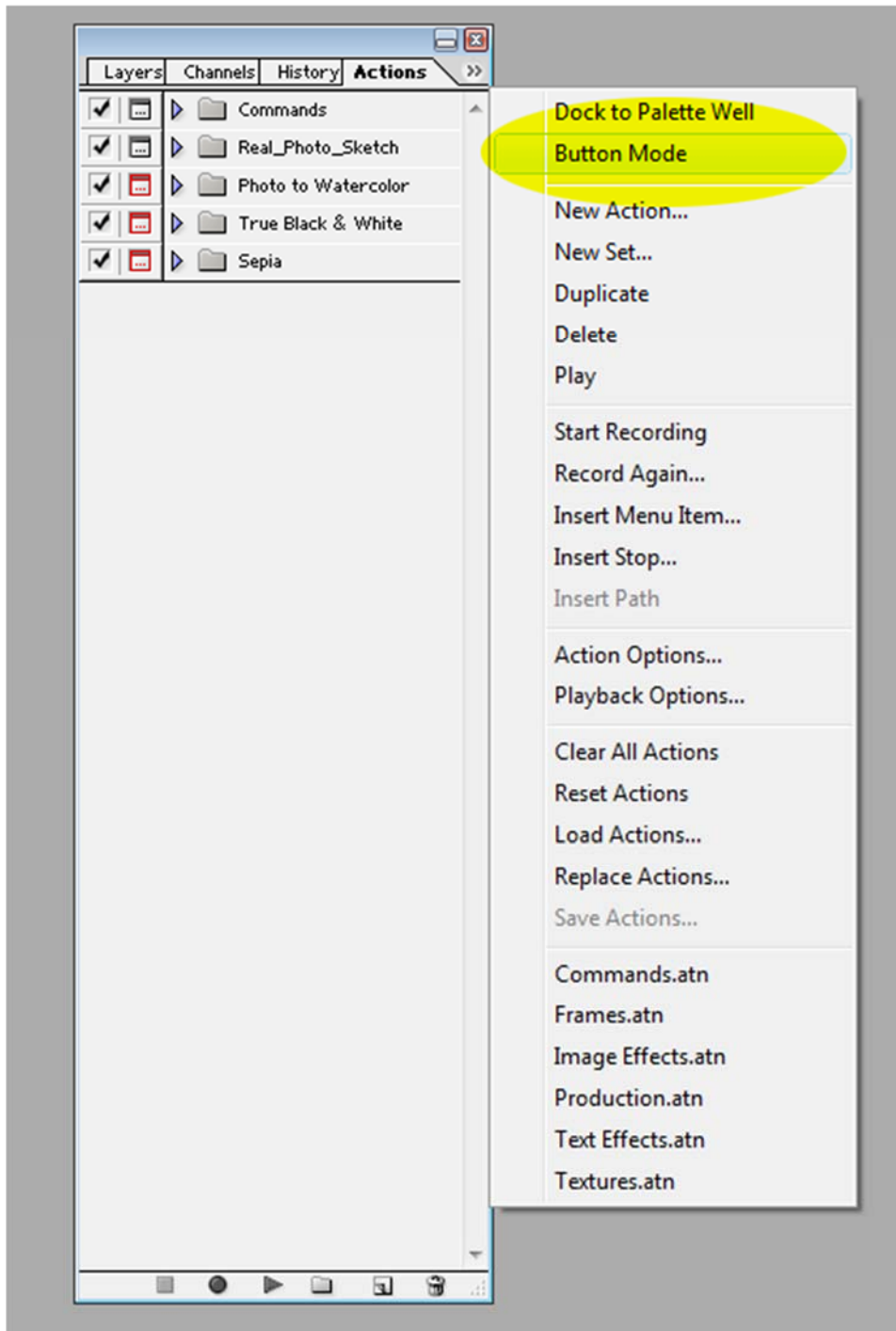
1. Open Photoshop
2. Open "Action" palette from the window dropdown menu. See example below.



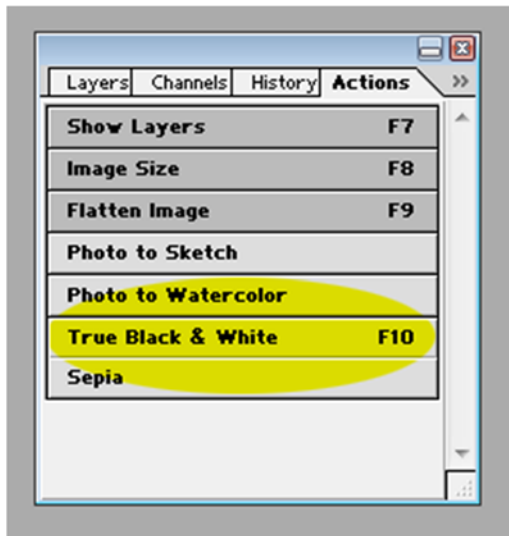
3. Load the actions by clicking on the double arrow ">>" see below.



4. Make sure the action palette is set to "button mode" by clicking on the double arrow ">>" again.



5. When the action palette is set to button mode it will look like this.



6. Open a photo and press the action button, then follow the instructions embedded in the action!
