Lay the net out flat on the ground so that the logos on the pockets are facing up and the black cross strap is underneath the netting.

## PRIORTO USE

Inspect the netting and frame for damage or wear. Make sure the frame and net are assembled correctly and on a flat surface at least ten (10) feet away from structures and vehicles. Failure to follow these precautions could result in serious injury or damage to property.


Run two of the poles through the top front and bottom rear sleeves by using the assembly windows.

Attach the four black corner joints to the two crossbars using the assembly windows so that they give structural form to the net's four corners. Make sure that the crossbars are seated all the way into the corner joints.


Wrap and black velcro straps around the red corner joints to secure the net.


Run the remaining four fiberglass poles through the net's side sleeves and attach them to the black corner joints. Make sure the fiberglass poles are seated all the way into the corner joints.


The attached stakes will keep your lacrosse goal securely in position.


Connect the two fiberglass poles to each other with the red corner joints that have stakes attached. These red corner joints will remain exposed. We suggest attaching the red corner joints to the base poles first, and then lifting the front of the goal up vertically so as to slide the front poles down into the corner joints. Make sure the fiberglass poles are seated all the way into the corner joints.

Fold your lacrosse goal by pushing the top front right corner diagonally down and back toward the rear bottom left corner. The net will then lay flat on the ground.


While keeping the front right side of the net on the ground, lift the front left side and fold it over so that the front top left corner lays on top of the rear bottom right corner. Your lacrosse goal will now be in a triangle shape laying flat on the ground.


Secure the goal flat by wrapping the red velcro straps (located in two different places) around both poles and corner joints to lock your goal flat.
